DAILY REFLECTIONS ON THE ASCENSION

Monday

Read Acts 1:1-11; 2:29-36. Where is Jesus after the ascension?
 What is He doing there? Eventually Jesus will defeat all the
 enemies of God (v. 34-35). Does it give you hope knowing Jesus
 is in control and will one day bring an end to all evil? Consider
 starting a day-long or week-long fast from secular news. It could
 replace anxiety and anger with hope!

Tuesday

 Read Ephesians 1:15-23 three times. Underline or list the things Paul prayed for the believers in Ephesus and by extension for you? Pray the same prayer for someone you love. Pray it for someone who is facing difficulty. Pray it for yourself.

Wednesday

Read Ephesians 2:1-10. What does it mean to be "seated...in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus? (v. 6-7) What did we do to deserve this? (v. 8-9). Since we are not saved "by works" but for "good works" (v. 9-10), ask God to show you what "good works" He has "prepared in advance" for you to do.

Thursday

Read Hebrews 4. How do people enter the "rest" of God? (v. 3)
 How have you found the Bible to be "living and active" in your
 life? (v. 12) Does it comfort or convict you knowing you are not
 "hidden from His sight"? (v.13). Read v. 14-16 again. Because
 Jesus ascended to become your high priest you have access to
 God's grace in your time of need. Bring your needs to Him now.

Friday

Read Hebrews 12:1-11. List what you are commanded to do in v.
 1. The race is "set before you." Runners in a race don't choose their own course. How does "looking to Jesus" help you run the race? What does God do to strengthen you for the race? (v. 7-11) God never wastes your pain but uses it to train you for righteousness and finishing the race.
