2. What are the virtues that make Lydia an admirable person?
3. Why are Paul and Silas arrested? What gives them the disposition to be able to sing in prison?
4. How are money and possessions a signifier of faith or unbelief in this passage? How is this tied to hospitality?
5. Note the differences between Lydia, Paul and Silas related to culture, gender and economic means. Have you experienced hospitality extended from someone quite different from you? How did it affect you?
6. How does this passage define “salvation”-from what threats and for what purposes are people saved?
7. How did the Lord open your heart to respond to the gospel? What people did the Lord use as part of the process?
8. Where do you have an “open door” for ministry now: In your home? School? Work place? Community? How will you step into this?

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
