Anjubo School in Haiti is changing lives by providing free education to children who need it most. This year, the school serves **88 students**, offering them uniforms, books, and materials at no cost. With your support, we can continue empowering these students to build a brighter future.



Growing and Adapting to Meet Needs

In response to demand, **Anjubo School added a Sixth Grade class** for the first time this year. To teach this new class, a qualified **new teacher** has been hired. This is a big step forward for the school, providing students with the chance to continue their education beyond the traditional grades.

However, the school faced challenges when **two classrooms collapsed in May**. Thanks to community support, two new classrooms were built, along with a **principal's office** and **12 new desks**. Despite these setbacks, Anjubo School is committed to providing a safe and supportive learning environment for all its students.

Recently, gangs tore down the gate, damaged the house, and destroyed our truck, prompting a necessary relocation. Thankfully, we had already prepared to move, and by God's grace, the children and staff are now safe in Area 44, three hours away.

A Fresh Start in Area 44

The children are adjusting well to their new home, and classes at a new school begin this month. One of our staff members sewed all the school uniforms, saving much-needed funds. Despite the hardship, the children's resilience and the dedication of our team shine through, providing hope for the future.

Bello Vincent's New Ministry

In addition to overseeing the Children's Home, Director Bello Vincent has helped start a new church in Area 44, where he preaches and invites the community to join in worship. Though still in its early stages, the church is a beacon of hope, and we pray for its growth and impact on the area.

The Crisis in Haiti: Violence, Displacement, and the Struggle for Hope



Haiti is in the midst of a severe crisis marked by escalating violence and political instability, exacerbated by the growing power of gangs. These gangs, fueled by infighting and criminal intent, have displaced over 700,000 people, including many connected to local ministries. The violence has forced innocent civilians, including families in areas like Gressier, to flee their homes in search of safety. As

gangs expand their control beyond Port-au-Prince into rural areas, the suffering continues to intensify.

Gangs and the Attack on Essential Institutions

The widespread violence has devastated essential institutions across Haiti. Churches, missions, and hospitals that have long been vital sources of spiritual, medical, and educational support are under siege. Many of these institutions have been forced to close or relocate, leaving communities without necessary services. Schools, once hubs of learning, have been shut down or repurposed as temporary shelters, further straining already limited resources. With airports also targeted, gang activity has disrupted aid delivery, including shooting at landing airplanes to control access. The lack of security has left Haitians without any reliable support systems.

Resistance Targeted

In the face of this violence, many have attempted to resist the gangs, including law enforcement officers. However, those who fight back are often killed. The inability of the police and other authorities to control the gangs has led to widespread insecurity, leaving the population vulnerable. Civilians have few options, as fighting back often leads to death, and submitting to gang rule becomes a matter of survival.

The Crisis in Haiti Cont.

Children in Gangs

One of the most heartbreaking aspects of this crisis is the involvement of children in gang activity. In some cases, as many as half of the gang members are minors, some as young as 10 years old. These children are often coerced or manipulated into joining gangs, where they are forced to participate in violence and crime. This exploitation robs them of their



innocence and future, as they become trapped in a vicious cycle of violence and fear.

Standing on God's Promises: Psalm 91

Amidst this terrifying situation, Christians are called to stand firm in their faith and trust in God's protection.

Psalm 91 offers powerful

comfort and reassurance: *"He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty."* (Psalm 91:1). This verse reminds us that, even in the darkest times, God is a refuge and fortress for His people. Christians around the world are urged to pray for Haiti, lifting up the safety of those caught in the violence and praying for the salvation of the gang leaders whose hearts are hardened by power and fear.

Praying for Haiti: Hope in the Midst of Despair

We ask fellow believers to join in prayer for Haiti—praying for the safety of the displaced, for the protection of Christian ministries, and for the children trapped in gang violence. Most importantly, we pray that the gang leaders may come to know Christ and be transformed by His love and grace. It is only through God's intervention that lasting peace and restoration can return to this broken nation.

Though the situation in Haiti is dire, we hold on to the hope that God hears our prayers and will act on behalf of His people. As we stand together in prayer, we trust that God's promises will bring healing and hope to Haiti, and that peace will one day return to the land.
