The purpose of **BTM** is to cast a vision among the next generation of church members and leaders for the necessity and urgency for missions by facilitating low-cost, hands-on, in-the-field training and experience. We aim to accomplish this goal through intensive one-week short-term mission projects which incorporate pastoral leadership, nightly preaching and teaching, daily ministry projects such as neighborhood evangelism and Vacation Bible Schools, and work projects in foreign language situations.

The plan is to assemble on the international border community of El Paso, TX and conduct short-term mission/ministry on both the US and Mexican sides of the border. The overarching rule guiding this ministry is to share the glorious gospel of Jesus Christ in every activity and encounter. With the Lord's help, we will:



✚ WORSHIP: Assemble for worship and the ministry of the Word on the Lord's Day. Pastor Dave Hendrickx will be preaching the Sunday morning and evening messages. We will travel to Mexico for a Spanish-language service Sunday afternoon at our Juarez church plant, Iglesia Bautista Pacto de Gracia.

✚ LEARN: Gather for preaching and teaching each night - Sunday through Thursday. We are pleased to announce our keynote

speaker again this year will be Dr. Tom Hicks, Senior Pastor, FBC, Clinton, LA. Pastor Dave will present a series of messages on 'gospel formation through redemptive church discipline' which he will introduce during the Sunday morning service.

✚ LABOR: Our construction project this year includes remodeling the apartment above Pacto de Gracia. If sufficient skilled workers are registered we will also do needed carpentry projects at STBC. Carpenters, electricians, and handymen w/tools are greatly needed.

✚ SERVE: Conducting three "1/2-day" VBSs concurrently on both sides of the border. Our enrollment in Juarez can easily exceed 100 children and teens.

✚ CONFESS: We confess our complete dependence upon God's grace, mercy and assistance as we strive to obey the Lord and see Him work in the lives of the children and in the churches God prepares for us.



WHO SHOULD ENROLL

This short term mission is designed for men and women between the ages of 18-30 yrs who have a passion for serving Christ in the field. All family members under 18 **MUST** be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.

BTM COST

The fee is \$175 per person. When accompanied by a parent, the family rate is \$150 per person. Fee includes all camp costs, meals, equipment rentals plus a free book titled *Discipline* by 9Marks. Children 7 and under are free.

INFORMATION

1. Each person is responsible for their own travel to and from El Paso, TX.
2. We will convene for dinner at the Santa Teresa Baptist Church, 5:30 PM - Saturday, July 20.
3. STBC comfortably supports about 40 people on campus. Space at the church will be assigned on a **first-come-first-serve** basis. BYO air mattresses, pillows, sleeping bags, towels and toiletries. Men and women are divided. Showers are available at the church building. Those choosing to stay at motels are required to provide their own transportation.
4. All meals will be prepared and eaten at the church. A brown bag will be provided to those that do not return to the church for lunch.

Lunch – served for VBS workers when they return
Dinner – 5:30 pm
5. Those traveling by air please provide Dave or Mitch arrival and departure info. Please arrive NLT 3 PM.

THE FINE PRINT

Passports/passport cards

Anyone planning to go into Juarez must be in possession of a valid passport or passport card. Birth certificates will not be accepted.



A passport which will allow you to travel anywhere in the world at this time is \$135 for adults, \$105 for under 16 yrs. The border card which allows for crossings into Mexico, Canada, the Caribbean, and Bermuda is \$55 for adults, \$30 for under 16 yrs. They can be applied for at your local post office. Permit yourself at least 6 weeks for processing.
