A Cry Room for your convenience is located at the back of the Sanctuary.



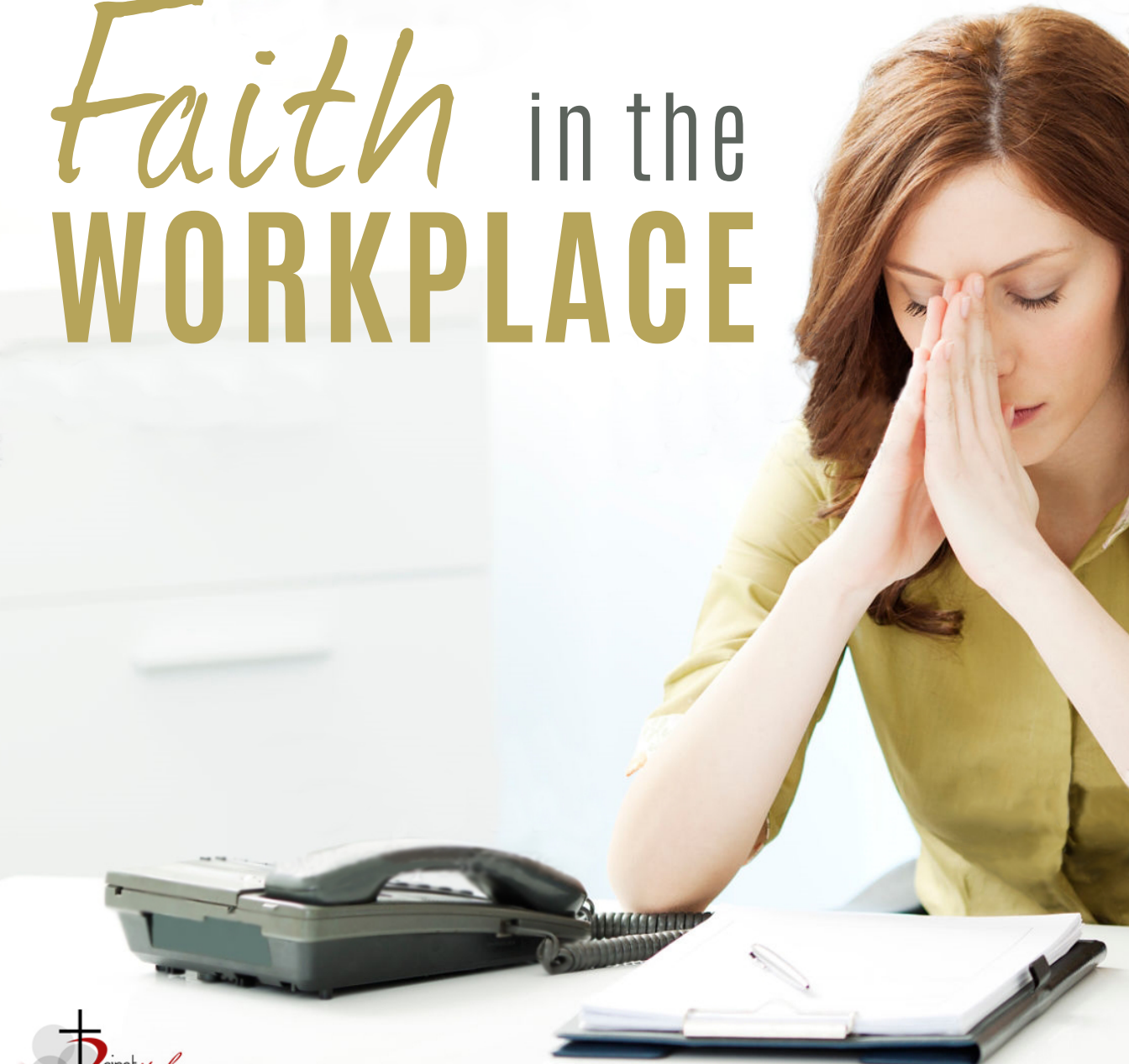
