DURING APRIL

- We will continue with our study in the book of Romans going through the rest of chapter 12 and the beginning of chapter 13. In light of the wonderful salvation and the righteousness we receive by faith in Christ, how should we live our daily lives? As we have seen, chapter 12 begins the answer to that question with presenting our bodies as a living sacrifice, and not being conformed to the world but being transformed by the renewing of our minds. The apostle Paul goes on to describe spiritual gifts and their exercise and Christian character and behavior. The first part of chapter 13 outlines our relationship and response to governing authorities that God has set up.
- At two consecutive Sunday Schools we will be going back to a section of chapter 8 (verses 18-25) which discusses the thought of 'the whole creation groaning'. With the current societal emphasis on 'going green', how should we as believers respond? How can we be good stewards of the world we physically inhabit? John will be exploring this topic in some detail during this time.

LOOKING AHEAD

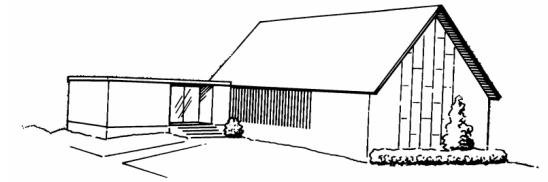
God willing...
