

# A DIVINE DIAGNOSIS

Week 41 | March 10, 2025

We are so **blind**, desperately *ignorant* to <u>the source</u> of our **pain** and **frustration**. Even when the veil is removed and we do begin to see, we are so *easily distracted* by <u>symptoms</u> on the surface and **led astray** by our *own feeble understanding* of what is going on. This is right where the Enemy wants us to remain, so busy <u>floundering in our failure</u> that we don't address **the foundation** of the issues at hand. In order to escape this vicious cycle of *symptom management* and receive the deeper <u>healing and restoration</u> that God longs to provide, we need **a diagnosis** of what is *really going on*. Let us <u>fight in prayer</u> for our families, churches, and communities this week, asking God to **identify the root** *sickness*, *wound*, or *brokenness* behind all of our <u>sin and pain</u>, inviting Him to:

## 1. SEARCH our Hearts. (Psalm 139:23)

- a. **NOTE:** The human heart is **incredibly complex**. Made up of various "*rooms*" and comprised of numerous "*layers*", only <u>our Creator</u> could ever hope to navigate its **depths** effectively. In order to determine and address the *underlying causes* of our life's struggles, we must <u>invite Him in</u> and give Him **free range** to *explore* and *examine* every aspect of who we are, <u>holding back no area</u> from His access. We must **walk with Him** in this search, allowing Him to take us into *memories* and *experiences* that lead to greater understanding and **fuller healing**. (Psalm 139:1; Psalm 44:21)
  - i. For Ex. "Lord God, thank You for making us so wonderfully complex. Thank You for designing and knowing every intricate detail of our hearts and lives. Come now, Lord, into these hearts You have created and search us deeply. You alone are able, and You alone do we trust. Walk us through the exploration of our souls, taking us deeper into the events of our past that have led to our present."
    - REMEMBER: Nothing He finds will surprise our Father. We are already completely known and <u>loved by Him</u> who created us. (<u>Psalm 139:13-16</u>)

# 2. DISCERN our Motives. (Psalm 19:12)

- a. NOTE: Nothing is done without cause. Often, though, our motivation for behavior is hidden from us and others by layers of deceit and walls of excuse. We have told and been told so many lies about why we do what we do. Only God can cut through all of our self-deception and expose the truth for what it is, shining His light upon the real source of our weakness and failure. This truth may be hard to face, painful to relive, or frightening to consider, but it is essential for our healing as we walk along the road to restoration. (1 Corinthians 4:5; John 14:17; John 8:32)
  - i. For Ex. "Father God, thank You for looking not only at the surface of our lives but also at what lies beneath. Come now and shine Your <u>light of truth</u> into our hearts, cutting through every **lie** and **deception** told and believed, and reveal to us the <u>true source</u> and **motivation** of our behavior. Lead us into <u>ALL truth</u>, Holy Spirit, and give us the **strength** and **courage** to face whatever we might find."

1. **REMEMBER:** Only God can *purify our motivation*, <u>cleansing our hearts</u> of all that is **not of Him**. (<u>Psalm 51:10</u>)

### 3. EXPOSE our Condition. (Psalm 139:24)

- a. NOTE: We have all been wounded, broken, or infected with sickness. Too often though we are unaware of our infirmity. Because of this ignorance, we are robbed of the treatment we desperately need. However, as God searches the depths of our hearts and discerns the truth about what is found there, He can then reveal to us the true nature of our condition. Ask God to show us where and how we are fractured, for as He exposes our need for healing we can then turn to Him who alone can provide it. (Daniel 2:22; Matthew 13:15)
  - i. For Ex. "Dear Lord, thank You for searching our hearts and for discerning the truth from the lies found there. Reveal to us now the true nature of our condition, showing us where we are in desperate need of restoration and repair. Expose to us the extent of our brokenness, making clear and obvious our need for You this day. Grant to us as well, Lord, the desire, power, strength, and humility to ask for and receive Your healing hand."
    - 1. **REMEMBER:** We may be *damaged*, but we are **never** beyond <u>His repair</u>. (Ezekiel 37: 1-14)

#### **Questions for Reflection:**

- What area of your heart and life have you held back from God?
  - He <u>already knows</u> and has chosen to accept you anyway. <u>Let Him in</u> and allow Him to speak to you there.
- Is there a truth of your past that you have struggled to face?
  - Walk through it with God and you won't face it alone. With Him at your side you can handle whatever it is.
- Where has God shown you that you are in need of healing?
  - Stop delaying your recovery. Take the time now to **receive** His *restoration* and *renewal*.
