

Eyes, Ears, & Hearts (Pt. 1) Week 23 | November 4, 2024

Part 1: Eyes to See (Proverbs 20:12; Psalm 119:18)

We are all **so broken**. We are *injured* as individuals, *fractured* as families, *cracked* as churches, and *corrupted* as communities. We are <u>all in desperate need</u> of Christ's timely and direct **intervention**. The *Good News*, though, is that Jesus gave us <u>the key</u> to experiencing **healing**, **restoration**, and **renewal** in *our lives*, *churches*, and *communities* thousands of years ago. It's not a matter of medicine, or a function of <u>time</u>. No, instead Christ tells us that the key to receiving God's **holy healing** is a matter of the *eyes*, *ears*, and *heart*. (Matthew 13:15)

Vision is essential to **growth**, forward **movement**, and **closeness** with God (Proverbs 29:18). Scripture makes it clear that our *spiritual sight* and *discernment* are the key to <u>pursuing and knowing</u> our Creator as we have been **called** and **created** to do. The problem is that we live in *a world of darkness*. In this time of <u>ignorance</u> and <u>blindness</u>, only a few **see the light**. Though it is *available to all*, only some will find and walk <u>the narrow path</u> that God has laid out for us. Thankfully, we serve a King who came to **give sight** to *the blind* by removing everything that <u>impairs our vision</u> including:

1. Scales & Veils (Acts 9:18; 2 Corinthians 3:14)

- a. NOTE: Scales and veils are the things in our life that obstruct our view. They keep us from seeing the truth and hold us back from experiencing all that God has in store for us. Often they are a result of our past experiences, upbringing, and traumas that have been left unresolved. They are strengthened and encouraged by the evil forces of this world and often require tremendous effort to remove. Amazingly though, our God has already done the work to peel away the scales and tear down the veil hindering our sight! (Ezekiel 13:21; Mark 15:37-38; 2 Corinthians 3:16-18)
 - i. For Ex. "Lord God, thank You for coming to bring sight to the blind and healing for the broken. Thank You for offering Your light to this sinful, fallen world and its sinful, fallen people. I ask, Lord, that You would work a miracle in our lives by removing the scales from our eyes and by tearing away the veil impairing our vision. Set us free from our past so that we can see You here in the present."
 - REMEMBER: The removal of scales often requires the assistance of others. (Acts 9:12,17)

2. <u>Fantasies</u> (Isaiah 41:29; Jeremiah 3:23-24)

a. **NOTE:** Fantasies are **deceptions** we have believed that eventually lead to <u>delusion</u>. Often starting out as *something good*, such as a **pleasant memory** or a **harmless ambition**, they quickly morph into <u>a wicked trap</u> designed to *ensnare* and *distract* us from **the truth** God wants us to <u>see</u> and <u>live</u>. Fantasies and delusions *blind us to reality* and provide **an escape** from <u>the facts of life</u> that are often too hard to bear. This escape is *misleading* and *short lived* though, for the **path of deception** always ends in <u>destruction</u>. (Proverbs 11:3; Ephesians 5:6; Isaiah 42:16)

- i. For Ex. "Father God, thank You for the truth that You give and which You ARE. Thank You for setting us free by this truth, for giving us life through Your truth. Please shine Your light into our lives today and expose all of our fantasies and delusions for the lies that they are. Cleanse us of all deceit and self-deception, giving us eyes to see and seek Your truth above all else."
 - REMEMBER: Holding on to fantasies leads to spiritual poverty and <u>ruin</u>. (Proverbs 28:19)
- 3. Blind Spots (Matthew 7:3-5; Psalm 19:12; Psalm 139:23-24)
 - a. **NOTE**: *Blind spots* are areas of sin in our lives that are **invisible** from our <u>point of view</u>. These are the things that *trip us up* when we **least expect it** and are the <u>shortcomings</u> that *everyone else* seems to see but that we **remain oblivious** to. The danger of a blindspot is that their <u>destructive power</u> is magnified by *our lack of awareness*. Only by gaining a **pious perspective**, meaning that of <u>God Himself</u>, can we hope to *avoid the catastrophe* that comes when these **gaps in our sight** are <u>left undealt with</u>.

(1 Corinthians 2:16; Romans 8:6; Ephesians 1:18)

- i. For Ex. "Lord Jesus, thank You for giving us Your mind at salvation. Thank You for the privilege it is to see things from your point of view. Please today remove every blind spot of sin from our lives, exposing anything and everything in, among, and around us that is not of You. Search us, Lord, and identify everything in our lives that is offensive to You. Give us the desire and power to see You, ourselves, and others from Your heavenly perspective."
 - REMEMBER: Attempting to guide others without addressing our own blindness will lead to <u>mutual destruction</u>. (<u>Matthew 15:14</u>)

Questions for Reflection:

- Have you been trying to fix your blindness on your own?
 - Humble yourself and ask for help. God gave us a spiritual family for a reason.
- What **fantasy** have you *fixated on*, thinking it was harmless?
 - Surrender your **fiction** for fact, because *the truth* is always better.
- Are you attempting to lead others down a path you cannot see yourself?
 - This is the way of <u>pride and hypocrisy</u>. Only once **our vision** has been *repaired* can we help our <u>brothers and sisters</u>.
