

FAITHFULLY FOCUSED

Week 59 | July 15, 2025

"Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things."

Colossians 3:2

Distractions can sneak in so easily. We **know** where <u>our attention</u> should be, **understand** the importance of <u>fixing our gaze</u> heavenward, but time and time again our focus tends to *drift downward*, back to the things of **this earth**. We forget that we are in <u>a war</u>, a war for *our hearts* that begins with **our eyes**. For where <u>our focus lies</u>, our *hearts will follow*.

Let us **do battle** this week on behalf of our *families*, *churches*, and *communities* and fight for their <u>focus</u> by asking God to give us His:

1. PRIORITIES (Matthew 6:33)

- a. NOTE: We focus on what's most important to us. Oftentimes when our focus has shifted it's due to a misalignment of priorities. God cares deeply about our earthly lives, about every aspect and dimension of our day to day existence. But He cares most of all about our soul; about the health, growth, and development of our spiritual selves. Too often, though, we neglect the spiritual for the sake of the physical. Caught up in the here and now, we lose sight of what has eternal ramifications. Thankfully, God can guard us from this mistake and keep our priorities firmly aligned with His own. (Psalm 119:37; Philippians 3:8)
 - i. For Ex. "Lord God, thank You for caring so deeply about us, for making us *Your priority* above everything else in creation. Forgive us, Lord, for all the times we have placed a higher priority on the *things of this earth* than the <u>things of heaven</u>, making idols of *the gifts* You have <u>blessed us with</u>. Cleanse us of all idolatry today, giving us instead priorities that *mirror Your own*, <u>aligning our heart</u> with Yours. Help us to see the **true value** of what is *really important*, as well as the <u>worthlessness</u> of everything else in comparison."
 - REMEMBER: Our priorities remain <u>aligned</u> as we remember our purpose. (<u>Colossians 1:16</u>)

2. PERSPECTIVE (2 Corinthians 4:17)

a. **NOTE:** When seen from our *point of view*, the things of this life can be overwhelmingly **large** and **pressing**, taking up virtually all of our <u>frame of vision</u>. This is one of the Enemy's favorite tools of **deception**, for the fuller our *eyesight* becomes, the more easily they are able to <u>move undetected</u>. The key to defeating these schemes is **elevation**—seeing things from *God's perspective*. From the <u>vantage point of heaven</u> and through the **lens of eternity**, the *distractions* of this life seem <u>much smaller</u> and **insignificant** by comparison. (<u>Matthew 6:22</u>; <u>Isaiah 55:9</u>; 2 <u>Corinthians 5:16</u>)

- i. For Ex. "Father God, thank You for giving us the mind of Christ at salvation, for giving us the ability and opportunity to think and see as You do. Help us today, Lord, to view the things of this life as You would, to examine them from Your perspective. Show us what is really going on, revealing to us the Enemy's schemes and our part to play in this great war. Expose the smallness of our problems in comparison to the greatness of Your power, helping us to see how it all resides within Your control."
 - 1. **REMEMBER:** *Elevation* comes through <u>humble submission</u> to God's **will** and **ways**. (James 4:10)

3. **PASSION** (Psalm 69:9)

- a. **NOTE:** We can't help but *fixate* on that which we are **passionate** about. Whether it be a new relationship, a sports team, or the latest hobby to catch our attention, the things we feel <u>intensely</u> about consume our **focus**. The Enemy knows this and therefore seeks to *smother our passion* for God, or at the very least <u>misdirect it</u> to lesser endeavours. The hopeful truth, though, is that a **passion lost** can be *regained*. A fire that has **smoldered** can be *rekindled*, **dry bones** can find *new life*. Our God is and always has been in the **resurrection** business after all. (Revelation 2:4-5; Psalm 51:12; Ezekiel 37)
 - i. For Ex. "Dear Lord, thank You for the passionate love You have displayed for us over the generations. Thank You for loving us so intensely that You sent Christ to die that we might live. For every fire in our hearts that has dwindled, fan it aflame again. For every desire that has been misdirected, set it straight once more. Ignite and direct a fiery passion in our hearts that leads to a laser focused pursuit of You above and before all else, burning away anything that stands in the way."
 - 1. REMEMBER: A passion from God cannot be contained. (Jeremiah 20:9)

Questions for Reflection:

- Have you **forgotten** your *purpose* in life?
 - We were made to know and be known by God, to love and be loved by Him. All of our priorities should **stem from** and center on this *relationship*.
- What area of your life is **lacking submission** to God's *will* or *ways*?
 - Please <u>humble yourself</u>, for as we **do** things *His way* we begin to **see** things *His way*.
- Have you been trying to keep **your passion** for God *bottled up* or *suppressed*?
 - Let it loose and <u>set it free</u>, for we were meant to live this life to **its fullest** with God as our focus!
