

# **FAKE FRUIT**

Week 37 | February 10, 2025

The "fake it till you make it" mindset has done more <u>damage to humanity</u> than we will ever realize. The problem **isn't** that we aren't <u>successful</u>, quite <u>the opposite</u> actually. We as humans are **extraordinary liars**, brilliant <u>actors in this grand play</u> that we find ourselves in. It's so <u>easy to pretend</u>, so simple to **act one way** in public while our <u>private thoughts and lives</u> remain much <u>different and darker</u>. The Bible teaches that we would be **known by our fruit**, but what about those whose fruit appears beautiful on the outside but <u>remains lifeless</u> and <u>rotting on the inside</u>?

"Nothing **fails** like success," as the saying goes, is true now more than ever before. There are so many in our families, churches, and communities who believe they are *right with God* because on the surface their lives <u>appear to be good</u>, or at least **not overly evil**. Since their *weakness isn't obvious* or apparent, they and others see <u>no reason for change</u> and certainly **no need for assistance**. This *fake fruitfulness*, the production of "good deeds" in <u>our own strength</u> and from **impure motives**, keeps us from *coming to God* in <u>humility and desperation</u> as we all must **to be saved** and live *the Christian life*. The cure for <u>this sickness</u> can and will be **painful**, **uncomfortable**, and **shocking**; but what our people desperately need is:

## 1. Exposure (Luke 8:17)

- a. **NOTE:** We often **hide** behind *our masks*, playing <u>make-believe</u> with **ourselves** and **others**, pretending that *we're okay* even when we <u>surely aren't</u>. The **lies** we tell *internally* and *externally* must be <u>revealed</u> and our **fake fruit** *exposed as such* in order for <u>God's healing</u> and **restoration** to take place. Only He can do so, for while we may see what's *on the surface*, our Father knows the true heart of man. (Eph. 5:11; Is. 44:25)
  - i. For Ex. "Lord God, thank You for shining Your light into the darkness of our lives, illuminating the path to life and revealing to Your people the hidden truths of Your word. Shine that light on us once more, exposing every toehold, foothold, and stronghold of sin in our lives. Break through all of the deception, revealing to us all of the lies told and believed. Pour out Your discernment, Father, making obvious all of the fake fruit and empty works that surround us."
    - 1. **REMEMBER:** Temporary **humiliation** is far better than eternal *damnation*. (Isaiah 57:12; Jeremiah 13:26)

# 2. Humility (James 3:13)

a. NOTE: When faced with humiliation we have two choices: 1. Embrace an attitude of humility and experience God's grace as a result, or 2. Dig deeper into our pride and reap the destruction that comes with it. Pray for those whose fraudulent fruit has been exposed, shamed, and discovered to humble themselves before the Lord so that He might pick them up in honor. (Proverbs 18:12; James 1:21)

- i. For Ex. "Father God, thank You for the *grace* of Your **humiliation**. Thank You for <u>exposing the sin</u> and *falsehoods* of our lives as such, revealing beyond a shadow of doubt how much we **desperately need You**. Grant to us the <u>grace of humility</u> in response to Your work, cultivating within us *an attitude* of **reverence**, **respect**, and **fear** that allows us to receive Your correction and *respond accordingly*."
  - REMEMBER: Our rock bottom becomes our bottom rock when we stop digging. (James 4:10)

## 3. Fertility (Luke 8:15)

- a. **NOTE:** Ground that has been **exposed** and **humbled**, cleansed of *all of the weeds* pretending to be <u>fruitful vegetation</u>, is soil fit to **receive God's word** and produce the *good fruit* that comes as <u>a natural result</u>. The key difference, **He is the one** producing the fruit *in* and <u>through us</u>. He is the **source**, **focus**, and **end result** of *a fruitful life*. If anything else lies <u>at the center</u>, it will lead to **barrenness** and spiritual **starvation**. (Philippians 2:13; John 15:5)
  - i. For Ex. "Lord, thank You for bringing life into the barren wasteland of our hearts. Thank You for the grace and gift of Your revival and renewal, for turning that which was dead into a <u>lush wilderness</u>. Please do so once more in the hearts of those who have experienced Your exposure and <u>humbled themselves</u> in response. Restore the soil of their hearts so that they may produce much fruit while leaning onto and into You, our true source of strength and power."
    - 1. **REMEMBER:** We **partner with God** in the *cultivation of our heart's soil*, but <u>only he</u> can make the plants **grow**. (1 Corinthians 3:6)

#### **Questions for Reflection:**

- What weakness, failure, or shortcoming are you hiding? Where are you pretending to be okay even though you aren't?
  - Remember, God already knows. He's been fully aware of who you are, all that you've done, and all that you will do from day one. Admit your need to Him and let Him join you in your weakness.
- What has been **your response** in the past to *humiliation*?
  - Choose today to <u>humble yourself</u>. A lesson **learned well** the first time need not be repeated again, for the <u>truly humble</u> cannot be **humiliated**.
- What fruit in your life has been produced by your own power and for the wrong motives?
  - Ask God to <u>cleanse you</u> of all <u>arrogant pride</u> and <u>selfish ambition</u> through the <u>power</u> of His blood. Then allow Him to work <u>in and through</u> to do <u>so much more</u> than you can even imagine.
