

HUNGER & THIRST (Pt. 1)

Week 19 | October 7, 2024

Without consistent **nourishment** our bodies will quickly *waste away*. The hunger pains and aches we experience are <u>God-given instincts</u> that signal to our brains what our bodies need in order **to survive**. Likewise, God has given us *a spiritual hunger* for more than the physical world can offer. On a basic level, all beings created <u>in God's image</u> have an innate desire to **know Him** and **be known** by Him.

However, the issue arises when after *prolonged exposure* to this <u>lost and fallen world</u> we live in those hunger pains become **diluted**, **drowned out**, or **temporarily appeased** by things other than our Creator. This week, we are praying for *a spiritual hunger* so intense that it <u>cannot be ignored</u> to fall on our people, churches, and communities that they might **turn to God** and receive *complete* and *lasting* <u>satisfaction</u>, asking God to give us a:

1. Craving for <u>HIS WORD</u>: (Deuteronomy 8:3)

- a. NOTE: When God created human beings He designed us for communication with Him. We were made to hear from God and when we lack His word in our life other forces are quick to try to fill that void. So many excuses abound for why we shouldn't have to read the Bible. So many reasons exist why people don't need to go to church. It's almost as if powerful forces have allayed themselves against our ability and opportunity to hear from God. Pray this week for the Holy Spirit to instill within us an unstoppable desire to hear from Him that can only be fulfilled through the written and spoken word of God. (Psalm 119:20; Psalm 119:31)
 - i. For Ex. "Lord God, thank You for placing within each of us a desire to know You and to hear from You. Thank You also for providing us with access to the *fulfillment of that desire* through <u>Your word</u>. I ask, Father, that You would intensify this longing within us and *overwhelm us* with a NEED to read, listen to, and consume Your word that <u>overcomes every excuse</u> and **defeats every** obstacle. May we find *satisfaction* in <u>nothing else</u>."
 - 1. **REMEMBER:** The *seeds of God's word* planted **in our hearts** produce <u>abundant fruit</u> in all seasons. (Psalm 1:2-3)

2. Yearning for <u>HIS VOICE</u>: (Psalm 85:8)

a. NOTE: Sometimes found *in the fire*, other times *in the storm*, and oftentimes heard in the *quietness of solitude*—God's voice is <u>all around us</u>. He often *speaks*, but we rarely listen. He frequently *talks to us*, but seldom do we hear. Often we are <u>too busy talking</u> ourselves to pause to hear a response. Other times we fail to receive His message because *we don't like the messenger*. Whatever the reason, we are missing out on a critical element of <u>our spiritual diet</u>. As we pray this week, ask God to give us a longing to <u>hear Him speak</u> that causes us to *seek*, *stop*, and *listen*. (Exodus 3:2-4; Job 37:4-5; 1 Kings 19:11-13)

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- i. For Ex. "Father God, I thank You for speaking to people like us who, on our own, are completely and totally insignificant. Thank You for placing value on and in us and for allowing us to hear Your voice. I ask, Lord, that You would unstop our ears, removing every proud hindrance to our hearing of You and giving us instead a palpable hunger to hear You speak. Oh God, please slow us down and shut us up so that we might receive Your response to our prayers, thereby participating in actual conversation with You."
 - REMEMBER: When everything and everyone else is <u>screaming for your</u> <u>attention</u>, focus on what **Your Father** is saying. God's voice alone can *drown out the chatter*. (Isaiah 55:2-3)

3. Dependence on HIS TRUTH: (Hebrews 2:1)

- a. NOTE: In a world where truth has become subjective, often varying based on the whims of the individual, we are in desperate need of a strong and unwavering foundation. God's truth is available to all and it has not changed, nor will it change, throughout all of time and history. Regardless of our feelings or circumstance, the truth of God stands firm—this is what we need today and is the only substance on which an unshakeable life can be built. Pray that God would give us an awareness of our need for this absolute as well as a desire to see it fulfilled that outweighs the strength and stubbornness of our pride. (2 Timothy 2:19; John 8:32; John 14:6)
 - i. For Ex. "Lord Jesus, thank You for coming as and revealing to us complete truth. Thank You for being the firm foundation on which we can build our lives. Please shine Your light into our hearts and reveal every lie we have believed as well as every area of sinking sand that is causing instability and chaos in our lives. Give us instead a love, affection, and longing for Your pure and undefiled truth that sets us free and restores our souls. Bless us also with a HATRED for deception, especially for the lies we tell ourselves."
 - 1. **REMEMBER:** God's truth is **offensive** to *our pride*. Without <u>humility</u> it is *impossible to accept* and will result in **our destruction**. (Luke 20:17-18)

Questions for Reflection:

- Have you cultivated the soil of your heart to receive and nourish God's word?
 - Pray for the Holy Spirit to work in you to <u>tenderize and soften</u> your heart by breaking up the **stony stubbornness** that has developed.
- Do you have trouble recognizing God's voice among all the others?
 - We best learn to <u>identify and disregard</u> the **counterfeits** by studying *the genuine*. Your time in <u>God's word</u> will train and equip you to **hear His voice**.
- What truth of God have you ignored or rejected because it offended your personal beliefs?
 - Repent of this <u>arrogance</u> before what was given as a cornerstone becomes a stumbling block in your life.
