

HUNGER & THIRST (Pt. 3) Week 21 | October 21, 2024

We all crave **approval**. We all long for someone to *look favorably* upon us and to *be pleased with* the <u>things we do</u> and the <u>way we behave</u>. It starts in childhood, when we look instinctively to our parents for **confirmation** and **validation**. As we grow older we begin to look elsewhere. Whether it be friends, peers, or mentors we seek to gain *esteem* and *acceptance* from the people around us.

This longing in our hearts is **God-given**, like all other *deep hungers* we feel. Because we serve a good God and a loving Creator, He does not give us desires without also **providing for** their fulfillment. **In Him** we are to *seek* and *find* the approval we so <u>desperately crave</u>. As we pray this week for our **families**, **churches**, and **communities**: ask God to re-instill within us a *hunger and thirst* for <u>His approval</u> that is comprised of and accompanied by a(n):

1. Fervor for HIS FAVOR. (Romans 11:7; Psalm 67:1)

- a. NOTE: Biblically, favor is defined as "gracious kindness and approval from a superior". Intellectually, most believers know that they want God's favor on their life. But too often, they have lost their passionate NEED (their fervor) for it in their life. Alternatively, when we are overwhelmed by this feeling there's nothing we won't do to please God and build His kingdom. The lost feel this need too, yet unfortunately they seek to gain God's grace by all the wrong means. The favor of God is not something that can be earned by obedience, instead it is a gift bestowed upon those who live by faith in Jesus Christ. (Galatians 4:10; Ephesians 2:8-9; Galatians 5:2-5)
 - i. For Ex. "Lord God, thank You for the amazing grace You show us each day. Thank You for the awesome gift that it is, freely given to all who trust in You. We need this grace, Lord, more than life itself. Open up our eyes, God, to see how desperate our need for Your favor truly is. Give us a hunger to see it poured out in our lives, to live in and experience Your hand of blessing as we act by faith."
 - 1. **REMEMBER:** Faith is **expressed through love**, love *fulfills the command of Christ*, and God's favor is shown to those who <u>remember His teachings</u>. (Galatians 5:6,14; Proverbs 3:1,4)

2. Longing for <u>HIS LOVE</u>. (Psalm 36:7; 1 John 4:10)

a. NOTE: God loves everyone, but not everyone gets to experience and receive His love in all its <u>fullness and richness</u>. As human beings, we were created to love and be loved. The sad reality, though, is that many have settled for the love of this world and have forsaken the love of <u>their Creator</u> for the cheap substitutes we find so easily. Our prayer, then, must be that all of the counterfeit would be <u>exposed as inadequate</u> in order for the genuine to be revealed and received. Ask God to inspire within us a <u>deep</u> and <u>unshakeable</u> desire to greater know and experience His love that leads us deeper into our <u>relationship with Him</u>. (John 3:16; Ephesians 3:17-19)

- i. For Ex. "Thank You, God, for loving us even when we are *unlovable*. Thank You for expressing that love while we were <u>still Your enemies</u>, sending Christ as the <u>sacrificial message</u> of *Your affections*. Give us <u>a longing</u>, Lord, to greater **know**, <u>understand</u>, live in, and <u>experience</u> Your love on <u>a daily basis</u>. Pull us to Yourself, God, through <u>this need of ours</u> to be loved and <u>expose</u> every *false* and <u>corrupted substitution</u> for what they truly are. In You alone is found <u>lasting</u> <u>satisfaction</u>, You alone deserve that place in our hearts."
 - 1. **REMEMBER:** God's love is **best felt** as it is *given to others*. (1 John 4:7-8)

3. Aching for HIS ACCEPTANCE. (Romans 4:1-3; Luke 15:20)

- a. **NOTE:** We all want to be **accepted**, to be *welcomed* and *received* with <u>open arms</u> by another. We long **to belong**, to be a part of something *bigger than ourselves*. God offers us this type of acceptance, inviting us to become a <u>part of His family</u> with our "warts and all". We don't have to **clean ourselves up** or *fix our lives* to receive <u>His warm embrace</u>, He extends the invitation as **a free gift** to all. Too often though, the Christian and the lost alike are *led off track* in pursuit of the <u>acceptance of others</u>. Sometimes God seems so distant, and the opinions of others so close, that it is **easy to compromise** under the *pressure of our peers*. Fight against this tendency in prayer, asking God to bless believers with a <u>contentment</u> in our acceptance by Him while **resensitizing** the lost to their need for *His approval*. (2 Corinthians 5:21; Romans 5:17)
 - i. For Ex. "Father God, thank You for making us righteous, holy and acceptable to You, through the sacrifice of Your son. Thank You for welcoming us into Your family, a privilege we could never deserve. Lord, please give Your children an unshakeable contentment in their acceptance by You so that the thoughts and opinions of others have no sway over their actions. For the lost, God, I ask that You would instill within them a supernaturally strong desire to be accepted that cannot be fulfilled by anything of this world. Draw them to Yourself, Lord, so that they might receive the true desires of their heart."
 - 1. **REMEMBER:** By **Christ's death** we were *made acceptable* to God, by His life we can live the same way. (Romans 12:1)

Questions for Reflection:

- Have you become <u>complacent</u> in your hunger for God's favor? Is it something you want or something you NEED?
 - Ask God to reveal to you how <u>desperately dependent</u> on Him you truly are so that your prayers and actions might reflect it.
- Have you grown **content** simply *knowing that* God will <u>always love you</u>?
 - WAKE UP. God's love is meant to be lived and experienced, not simply understood.
- Whose acceptance and approval is your highest priority?
 - o If the answer is anyone but God, <u>idolatry</u> has gained **a foothold** in your life. *Reorganize* your priorities before the Lord's hand comes against that <u>false god</u>.
