

JABEZ: PART 2 Week 49 | May 6, 2025

"Oh, that You would bless me indeed, and enlarge my territory¹, that Your hand would be with me², and that You would keep me from evil³, that I may not cause pain!"

1 Chronicles 4:10

As discussed last week, we should certainly be praying for God's blessed **expansion**, **favor**, and **protection** over our *families*, *churches*, and *communities*. The problem is that Satan, this world, and our flesh will seek to <u>steal</u>, <u>kill</u>, <u>and destroy</u> all that is **holy** and **good** in our lives, striving to rob us of *every blessing* that God bestows. With that in mind, we can incorporate <u>the Prayer of Jabez</u> into our daily warfare against **the true Enemy** in the lives of *our loved ones* (<u>Ephesians 6:12</u>) and ask our <u>righteous King</u> to curse His enemies through:

1. **REDUCTION** (<u>Luke 10:18</u>)

- a. **NOTE:** The Enemy is only as effective as **their reach** allows. When we pray for a reduction in their territory we partner with God in limiting the <u>influence and impact</u> of Satan and his forces in the lives of those around us. Power is found in **authority**, and as Evil is *cast down* from their <u>formerly high positions</u>, good is able to take its **proper place**. As a bonus, when those *in partnership* with the Enemy experience <u>this reduction</u>, it is often a **turning point** in bringing them back to God. (John 3:30; Judges 6:6)
 - i. For Ex. "Father God, thank You for allowing us entry into Your kingdom, for expanding its territory into our lives as You rescued us from the kingdom of darkness. Please continue to do so in, among, and around our lives today. Tear down every toehold, foothold, and stronghold of evil, bringing the forces of darkness low beneath the footstool of Your judgement. Limit and reduce their influence and impact, Lord, destroying any form of authority they may have."
 - 1. **REMEMBER:** Rock bottom can serve as a firm foundation. (1 Pet. 5:10)

2. OPPOSITION (James 4:6)

a. NOTE: God has not left this world to its **own devices**. He is still *actively at work*, showing favor to some and **opposition** to others. When the *hand of God* is seen powerfully at work, **pushing back** and knocking down *proud obstacles* that seek to obstruct His truth, the kingdom of Heaven is advanced. This further serves to mark a **clear distinction** between God's people and the Enemy's and allows for others to be drawn to the Father who can truly save them. (Job 31:23; 1 Corinthians 10:5)

- i. For Ex. "Lord God, thank You for opposing us in our *pride and arrogance*, for humiliating us when we refused to humble ourselves. Grant Your enemies in our lives the same mercy this day, sending Your hand of opposition against them in all that they do so that they might turn to You instead. Reveal Your mighty power and righteousness today, Lord, making the distinction between good and evil clear so that all who witness it might learn to know You."
 - 1. **REMEMBER:** How we respond to **God's opposition** determines <u>how long</u> we experience it. (1 Peter 5:6)

3. **DESTRUCTION** (2 Corinthians 10:4)

- a. NOTE: While God certainly prefers to **demonstrate His power** through *the blessings* of His children, He is <u>just as glorified</u> through the **destruction** of *their enemies*. God is **good**, therefore all that He says and does is *good as well*. This means that even the <u>pain and destruction</u> that He **sends** or **allows** into our lives is *for our good* and for the <u>good of others</u>, for the **merciful misery** of God is *a wonderful tool* in bringing about repentance. (<u>Proverbs 16:4</u>; <u>Week 39</u>)
 - i. For Ex. "Dear Lord, thank You for destroying that which we used to be in order to bring about <u>our rebirth</u> into all we were meant to be. Please continue the work of Your <u>holy destruction</u> today, completely demolishing all that is Evil in, among, and around our lives. <u>Bring on the pain</u>, Lord, that turns the wicked from their foolish ways and pushes them into <u>Your loving arms</u> that offer healing, freedom, and protection."
 - REMEMBER: God loves to bring beauty from the ashes of our destruction. (<u>Isaiah 61:3</u>)

Questions for Reflection:

- Has God reduced your territory, limited your influence, or hindered your impact?
 - How far does He have to go before you get the hint? Stop seeking to build your kingdom and aim to advance His instead.
- How have you responded to the opposition of God in your life?
 - Prideful arrogance serves to do nothing but <u>make things worse</u>. Surrender your entitlement so that God might *bless your humility* instead.
- What has God sought to destroy in your life that you continue to hold onto?
 - Ashes only come on <u>the other side</u> of the fire. Whatever it is, give it to Him. The beauty He offers **far outweighs** whatever you're clinging to.
