

LIGHT in the DARK Week 18 | September 30, 2024

We live in a **lost and fallen** world, surrounded by a *kingdom of darkness*. While this is easy to believe and say when things are <u>going okay</u> for us, it's quite another thing to **realize it for yourself** when we are *personally confronted* with that darkness. When we're neck deep in <u>the pain of loss</u> or face to face with <u>the reality of suffering</u>, the night can seem **unending** and the despair can quickly **overwhelm** us. *God knew this*, He knew these days were coming, and so He left us with <u>an amazing</u> <u>aift</u> to **overcome** this *evil time* we find ourselves in. (Ephesians 6:12; 2 Corinth. 4:4; Colossians 1:13)

Throughout scripture Christ is referred to as the "light of the world", a **source of hope** in times of darkness, leading to *life everlasting*. Jesus then takes this already amazing promise a step further when He declares that we, as <u>His followers</u>, are also **the light of the world**. Because of Christ in us, we have the *capacity* and *responsibility* to <u>reflect His light</u> and <u>reveal His glory</u> to the world we live in. (John 9:5; Matthew 5:14)

So why does this matter? What does this mean in **times of trial** and how should it *lead us to pray* for the people, churches, and communities that we're a part of? This matters because the <u>people of this</u> <u>world</u> need the light of Jesus. They need to be **rescued** from the *kingdom of darkness* and **transferred** into the *Kingdom of Light*. It matters, because <u>God in His wisdom</u> decided that we as *His children* are to be <u>beacons of light</u> to all of the *lost souls* we are surrounded by, that through us they would **see Him**. This isn't easy even on <u>our best days</u>, let alone when everything is *falling apart*. Our only hope of success comes when we live in <u>alignment with Him</u> and are **filled with** and **focused on** *His light* that:

1. <u>GUIDES</u>: (John 8:12)

- a. **NOTE:** In times of loss, **confusion abounds**. It can be the hardest thing in the world just to put *one foot in front of the other* and keep moving in <u>a straight line</u>. When we're tempted to **wander**, or pulled to **drift**, the Light of the Lord keeps us on *the right path* and prevents us from <u>stumbling</u>. Like **a lighthouse** on the beach, God's light helps us navigate *treacherous waters* and make it safely to shore. (John 11:9; Ephesians 5:14)
 - i. For Ex. "Father God, thank You for sending Your light into this world and for placing it *in our hearts*. Please keep <u>the focus</u> of Your children on You so that their paths might be *illuminated* and You can keep them <u>from falling</u>. As Your followers, Lord God, use us to shine Your light into the lives of those around us so that they might *see*, *know*, and *find* the <u>way to life</u> and escape that path that <u>leads to death</u>."
 - 1. **REMEMBER:** When we **turn away** from the light we end up *walking in shadows*, and there we will <u>surely stumble</u>. (John 11:10)

2. DRAWS: (Isaiah 60:3)

- a. NOTE: Like moths drawn to a flame, God's light has an attractive force to it that <u>pulls</u> <u>us in</u> and **brings us close**. This force is even more *powerful* and *effective* in dark times, as it shines all the <u>more prominently</u> and offers **refuge** and **respite** to those in *desperate need*. As Christians, <u>times of trial</u> can be **opportunities** to *reveal this light* to those around us so that <u>everyone can see</u> the God we serve. (John 6:44; Matt. 5:15-16)
 - i. For Ex. "Holy Spirit, thank You for drawing us to You so that we could be saved. Thank You God for *calling us to Yourself* and <u>pulling us away</u> from our old lives. Please continue to do that same good work in and through our lives so that everyone around us *might see You* and come to *know You*. May the fruit of our lives offer a good testimony of the God we serve, bringing *glory to Your name* and <u>advancing Your kingdom</u>."
 - 1. **REMEMBER:** It is **not our job** to draw people to God, we are simply to be *faithful* and *effective witnesses* telling of <u>His glory</u>. (John 1:8)

3. EXPELS: (John 1:5)

- a. NOTE: The truly beautiful thing about light is that it has the power to expel darkness. No matter how deep the night, no matter how hopeless the situation, no matter how painful the circumstance–God's light <u>can overcome</u>. This same power resides in us, fills us, and flows from us as we look on Jesus. The Bible tells us that the "gates of hell" <u>will not prevail</u> against God's people when they are firmly planted in His word and that instead His kingdom will be forcefully advanced. In evil times, we must <u>cling</u> even more tightly to the light which first set us free and has the power to expel all darkness. (Luke 11:36; Matthew 6:22; Ephesians 5:8)
 - i. For Ex. "Dear God, thank You for the **freedom** that comes from accepting Your light. Thank You for *rescuing us from darkness* and <u>dwelling in our hearts</u>. I ask, Lord, that You would **fill us to the brim** with Your light that any and all traces of evil might be *expunged*. May Your light and glory <u>flow through us</u> and **eradicate** the *forces of darkness* in, among, and around our lives so that the <u>Kingdom of Heaven</u> might be **advanced** and the <u>powers of Hell</u> **thwarted**."
 - 1. **REMEMBER:** Those in **partnership with darkness** will *hate the light* and will work to *extinguish it* before it <u>exposes their nature</u>. (John 3:20-21)

Questions for Reflection:

- Have you wandered from the right path or gotten lost in the fog of this life?
 - <u>Seek God</u> and let Him **guide you back** to where you went wrong. Only then can you experience *true intimacy* with Him.
- Does your life **reveal God's glory** to those around you in a way that *points them to Him*?
 - Ask God to <u>cut away</u> anything preventing His light from **shining through**. He can then use you to *pull others to Himself*!
- Are you partnering with the King of Light or the Prince of Darkness?
 - Renounce every <u>demonic agreement</u> that has been made by **rejecting Satan's lies** and replacing them with *the truth*.
