

STIRRING HEARTS Week 50 | May 13, 2025

Our hearts can **grow still**, becoming *stagnant* and <u>nearly frozen</u> like a mud puddle in the middle of Winter. This is **not** how we were meant to be. Our hearts were *made for motion*, designed to rush and flow like <u>a great river</u> at the height of Spring! We were **made for passion**, to *live and love* with <u>intensity</u>, not apathy. Above all else we were made to **love God** and *live for Him* in this way.

The Enemy knows this and spends much of their **time**, **energy**, and **effort** seeking to *restrict the movement* of our hearts, or at the very least <u>divert them</u> away from God. In response to this **desperate need** and our *Enemy's assaults*; let us pray this week to the only One who can truly "stir our hearts" like no other, asking Him to:

1. **Set us AFLAME** (<u>Luke 24:32</u>)

- a. NOTE: Discouragement and depression are like ice in our veins, freezing our hearts from the inside out. That is why the Enemy's attacks are always focused where we are most vulnerable, where it will hurt the most. Their aim is to reduce the fire of our heart to nothing more than a barely smoldering ember, weighing us down by the pressures of this life, smothering the light inside us with a blanket of overwhelmedness. Hope is not lost, though, for our God has proven time and time again that He can set aflame even the most fire-resistant substances. (Psalm 42:5-6; 1 Kings 18:33-39)
 - i. For Ex. "Lord God, thank You for being our 'devouring fire', able to ignite and reignite even the coldest of hearts. I ask now that You would be with the downtrodden, all those whose hearts are weighed down by the Enemy's attacks of depression and discouragement, all those who are feeling overwhelmed and exhausted. Stir their hearts, Lord, setting them aflame from the inside out and burning away every trace of the Enemy's influence."
 - 1. **REMEMBER:** Fires *go out* when their fuel is <u>exhausted</u>. To keep them alive we must **keep them fed**. (<u>Psalm 36:7-9</u>)

2. Shake us AWAKE (Psalm 57:8)

a. **NOTE:** When they fail to *diminish* our <u>heart's flame</u> through **depression** or **discouragement**, the Enemy will often then attempt to *lull the people* of this world into a <u>deadly slumber</u> built on a false **sense of security** and an *attitude of complacency*. If everything is alright and nothing is wrong, <u>what need</u> do we have for God? This trap has **devastating consequences** for those caught in its snare, for a heart that is *immobile* easily becomes <u>poisoned and bitter</u> to the taste. Only God can rouse us from **this sleep**, *waking us* to the reality of <u>our need for Him</u> and the world's **need for His people**. (Proverbs 1:32; Revelation 3:16; Matthew 5:14)

- i. For Ex. "Father God, thank You for raising us from our slumber and giving us new life. I lift up to You all those who have <u>drifted off</u> once more, <u>lulled to sleep</u> by the lies of the Enemy, as well as those who have <u>never woken</u> for the first time. Shake their lives, Lord, violently if need be, in order to rouse them from <u>their drowsiness</u> and awaken them to their <u>need for You</u>. Snap them out of their complacency and <u>lethargy</u>, <u>stirring their hearts</u> in order to free them from <u>apathy</u>."
 - 1. **REMEMBER:** God often *awakens us* by shining <u>His light</u> into our lives, revealing what was **hidden**. (Ephesians 5:13-14)

3. Steer us ALONG (Proverbs 21:1)

- a. **NOTE:** When the Enemy is not successful at *quenching our flame* or <u>caging us</u> with **complacency**, they will often turn to even *shrewder tactics*. If they cannot prevent our hearts from <u>being stirred</u>, then they will do everything in their power to **deceive** and **distract** them from the direction *God intended*, aiming to <u>mislead us</u> onto the path that leads to our **inevitable destruction**. Scripture teaches that our hearts are *easily fooled*, often <u>led astray</u> by the lies of the Evil One. But God also promises to give **wisdom** and **discernment** to those who ask, *granting us* the ability to <u>see, hear, and know</u> His **will** and His **way**. (<u>Proverbs 14:12</u>; <u>2 Corinthians 11:3</u>; <u>Jeremiah 17:9</u>; <u>James 1:5</u>)
 - i. For Ex. "Dear Lord, thank You for sending Jesus to make a way for our salvation and abundant life. Thank You for guiding us onto this path, since it is hard to find. I lift up to You now all those whose hearts have been stirred by You, those who have felt and responded to the calling on their lives. Continue to lead, guide, and direct us as we act on the passions You have given us, keeping us far from the road of destruction and firmly fixed instead on Your path of life."
 - REMEMBER: Those we are surrounded by have a tremendous impact on the direction of our lives. Guard your heart against those who would influence it for evil. (1 Corinthians 15:33; Proverbs 4:23)

Questions for Reflection:

- Has the fire of your heart gone out for lack of nourishment?
 - Take the time to be fed by God, only He can **truly sustain** you.
- What is God's light revealing in your life?
 - o It may be blinding at times, painful even, but what it reveals is always for our good.
- What **direction** do the people in your life *encourage you to travel*?
 - <u>Limit the access</u> of those who **pull you away** from God and *strengthen your bonds* with those who <u>push you closer</u> to Him!
