

THE SHIELD OF FAITH

Week 55 | June 17, 2025

"In addition to all of these, hold up the **shield of faith** to stop the fiery arrows of the devil."

Ephesians 6:16

A **good archer** can *exploit the cracks* in any armor, targeting those gaps between the pieces in order to find a way of <u>injuring the soldier</u> underneath. This is when **a shield** is *essential*. As a mobile <u>defensive covering</u>, shields are vital in **absorbing** Enemy *blows*, **redirecting** their *attacks*, and **stopping** many of their *assaults* dead in their tracks. Protection like this is what allows a soldier to <u>advance</u> even in the **thick of battle**, taking ground even as the arrows fall *all around them*.

God has given us <u>a covering</u> like this. Our shield of faith is **a gift** from above that *gives us power* to see *God's* <u>hand at work</u> here on earth (<u>Ephesians 2:8</u>; <u>Matthew 21:21</u>). This faith can be **strengthened** by prayer (<u>Mark 9:24</u>), but what *kind of faith* do we need? In this <u>time of trial</u> and this **season of turmoil**, what we need is a faith that is:

1. **BOLD** (Hebrews 11:1)

- a. NOTE: Weakness and timidity have stifled the lives and prayers of Christians for far too long. The Enemy has convinced many believers that in order to be a good follower of Christ, to be truly humble and meek, that they must also embrace an attitude of hesitation and indecision, fearfully second-guessing everything in life—including and especially themselves. This mindset ruins our effectiveness and slows the advancement of the Gospel to a snail's pace, just as Satan desired. What we really need, what this lost and dying world needs, is men and women of God who are willing to boldly pray, speak, and live out their faith. (2 Timothy 1:7; 2 Corinthians 3:12)
 - i. For Ex. "Lord God, thank You for gifting us Your Spirit as evidence of our adoption into the family. You are neither weak nor timid, and neither is Your Spirit. Instead, You are bold and courageous, powerful in both word and action. Fill us today with that same confidence, inspiring us with a fiery faith that knows no fear, but instead overwhelms all anxiety. Silence the voice of the Enemy in our hearts, and instead teach us Your way of living in power, love, and self-control."
 - REMEMBER: Miracles come as we take a <u>leap of faith</u>, but courage is essential in doing so. (<u>Matthew 14:29</u>)

2. ACTIVE (<u>James 2:17-18</u>)

a. NOTE: If the Enemy can't stop you from believing they will do everything in their power to stop you from acting on those beliefs; for even Satan knows how useless fruitless faith truly is. We don't need anymore "arm-chair quarterback" believers, Christians attempting to safely evangelize from the comfort of their couch or the safety of their pew. We need a faith that sparks mobility, that compels action, that results in movement, change, and progress. We need a faith that leads us to walk what we talk and show the world the God we serve by our actions and behavior.

(James 2:26; 2 Corinthians 5:7)

- i. For Ex. "Dear God, thank You for being a god who not only speaks but acts. Thank You for revealing and demonstrating who You are through all of Your various works and deeds, for showing us Your nature through the life of Jesus. Give us today a faith that moves not only mountains, but our feet as well. Give us a faith that compels us to act and inspires us to live out what we believe. Overwhelm our tendency towards inaction, Lord, and drive us into a motion that mirrors Your own."
 - 1. **REMEMBER:** *Inaction* is really **regression**, if we aren't <u>moving forward</u> we're *sliding backward*. (<u>Revelation 3:15-16</u>)

3. **FOCUSED** (<u>James 1:6-8</u>)

a. NOTE: Faith can be misplaced and misdirected. Like grabbing the wrong shield as we head into battle, when we place our faith in anything but God alone we trade our impenetrable defense of steel for one made of flimsy plastic. Is it any wonder then that it quickly buckles and disintegrates under the attacks of the Enemy? To avoid this mistake and the devastating consequences that follow, we must remain laser focused on the source and sustainer of our faith, blind to every attempt to distract or divert our attention and holding tightly to He that is our firm foundation.

(Hebrews 12:2, Isaiah 26:3, Isaiah 28:16)

- i. For Ex. "Dear Lord, thank You for initiating and perfecting our faith, for providing us the perfect example on which to focus. Grant us today Holy Blinders against anything that might attempt to distract or divert our attention, keeping our gaze fixed firmly on You instead. Reveal to us every area that we have placed greater faith in something other than You, exposing our counterfeit shields for the poor substitute they truly are. For You alone are worthy of all our trust. You alone are our firm foundation."
 - 1. **REMEMBER:** We *face towards* what we **focus on**. The most courageous movement is <u>wasted</u> if we're heading in the *wrong direction*. (Ps. 119:59)

Questions for Reflection:

- Has your courage failed as you're waiting for a miracle?
 - Love is the true source of all bravery, ask God to **refuel** yours today!
- Have you backslidden in your complacency?
 - The best way to retake that ground is one-step at a time. The best time to start is today!
- Has your bravery been wasted in wayward movement?
 - Sometimes we have to <u>turn around</u> and **go back** to where we *veered off course*. Don't grow <u>discouraged</u>, the sooner you do so the shorter distance you have to travel!
