

THE SWORD OF THE SPIRIT

Week 57 | July 1, 2025

"...take the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God."

Ephesians 6:17

This world we live in is **dangerous**. More like *the wild west* than a <u>peaceful utopia</u>, a **spiritual war** continues to *rage all around* us. We have seen how God has <u>not</u> left us defenseless, learned how he has offered us a variety of different **protective measures** ranging from *peace* that guards our feet to <u>salvation</u> that covers our head. However, we were **not** meant to play a *merely defensive* role in these battles. We are <u>warriors</u>, equipped by God to fight **the good fight** and *take back ground* from the Enemy. The tool He gives us is <u>His word</u>. The same **weapon** Christ Himself used to combat Satan's temptation in the wilderness is *available to us* today! The word of God is <u>alive and active</u>, and in our **great need** it continues to offer:

1. **STABILITY** (Matthew 7:24-25)

- a. NOTE: God's word keeps us **grounded**. Because *His promises* are <u>always proven true</u>, the word of God offers us **strength**, **stability**, and **security** even in the *harshest of storms*. Made of only the <u>strongest and purest</u> material, His blade is able to cut through every attack of the Enemy and **reveal the truth** in place of *every lie* that has been spread. When the <u>forces of darkness</u> come against us, we can **stand firm** and *take ground* as we <u>remember and apply</u> God's word to **whatever situation** we find ourselves in. (<u>Hebrews 6:18</u>; <u>2 Timothy 2:19</u>; <u>Psalm 33:11</u>)
 - i. For Ex. "Dear Lord, thank You for Your word. Thank You for equipping us with the truth necessary to combat the evil of this world. Thank You for Your promises that will always prove true. Build our lives on this truth, Lord, so that when the lies of the Enemy attack we can <u>cut through them</u> with ease. You have called us to stand firm, to take ground for Your kingdom, and You have given us the tools necessary to do so. Teach us to use them, Lord, so that we will not stumble or be shaken, and <u>bring to mind</u> Your word when we need it the most."
 - 1. **REMEMBER:** The Enemy will *twist God's word* in an attempt to **destabilize** and **destroy** our faith. (Matthew 4:5-6)

2. SUSTENANCE (Matthew 4:4)

a. NOTE: By God's word everything in *all of creation* came to be, <u>including us</u>. It is also by His word that we are **sustained**. His word is the *nourishment* that we <u>truly need</u>, the **bread of life** that *keeps us going*. Too many christians have fainted in the <u>midst of battle</u> due to a **lack of energy**, their passion having been *drained* and *exhausted* by their <u>spiritual malnourishment</u>. This is exactly where the Enemy wants us: **weak**, **vulnerable**, and **cut off** from our *source of power*, for the only thing better than <u>a defenseless victim</u> is **a powerless one**. (<u>John 1:1-5; Deuteronomy 8:3</u>)

- i. For Ex. "Father God, thank You for creating and sustaining everything in this world, including us. Thank You for sending Your word to serve as our holy nourishment, as our very source of life itself. Revive us by Your word, Lord, speaking specifically into our hearts and lives today to refresh and restore Your weary children. Give us a hunger and a thirst to hear from You, to sit under the sound of Your voice, and turn every counterfeit word into ashes in our mouth. For You alone will do, Father, Your word alone is what we need."
 - REMEMBER: Even the most satisfying meal is only effective when consumed. (<u>Jeremiah 15:16</u>)

3. SURGERY (Hebrews 4:12)

- a. NOTE: With all of its **severity** and oftentimes *harsh truths*, it can be easy to forget that the word of God is always spoken with <u>our good</u> in mind. God **loves us** and wants *the best* for us, He longs to make us <u>whole and holy</u>. This process often involves **spiritual surgery**, allowing God's word to penetrate our *hearts and souls* in order to <u>cut away</u> that which is **poisoning us** from the inside. The *wounds of our past* continue to affect us in <u>the present</u>, but we can choose today to **invite His truth** into our lives so that the *healing process* can <u>begin with us</u> and spread to **others**. (<u>Psalm 107:20</u>; <u>Prov. 4:20-22</u>)
 - i. For Ex. "Dear Lord, thank You for Your word that is sharper than any sword. Thank You for wielding it as a surgeon and a friend in our lives, for using it for our good and our good alone. Come deeply into our hearts and lives today with Your word and truth, using Your spiritual scalpel to cut away every lie believed, every coping mechanism relied on, and all of the scar tissue that has formed from our mishandled wounds. Search us, Lord, reveal to us where You are working in our lives that we might join You there."
 - 1. **REMEMBER:** Refusal to *heal* is planning to **hurt**. (Numbers 16:48)

Questions for Reflection:

- Has the Enemy twisted God's word in your life to confuse, distract, or discourage you?
 - Take it back to <u>its core</u>, to the **motivation** and **heart** behind what is being said. If you look behind the curtain you will find out if God is speaking or not.
- Are you weary and weak from a lack of spiritual nourishment?
 - Take the time <u>today</u> and allow God to **pour into you**. Dehydration is *deadly* to our <u>hearts</u> and *destructive* to our <u>ministry</u>.
- Is there a place in your life that you won't give God's word access to?
 - Let Him in to do His <u>surgical work</u>. The longer you **delay**, the *more suffering* you and others will face as a result.
