

WASTED WORDS

Week 38 | February 17, 2025

Words matter. **What** we say and **how** we say it has a *tremendous impact* in <u>our lives</u> and those <u>around us</u>. The **children of God** have an even more *incredible ability* to <u>speak literal life</u> into someone's heart as we share with them **the Good News** of Christ and all that He *can and wants to* do for them. By our words we can <u>build up another</u>, **encouraging** the *work of God* in their life, or plant <u>seeds of destruction</u> that will **divide** and **distract** from the *freedom* and *healing* that the Lord has in store. Is it any wonder then that scripture often describes the **importance** of words and the **severity** of *their consequences*? (<u>Proverbs 10:11</u>; <u>James 3</u>; <u>Matthew 12:36</u>)

As one of the **favorite tools** of <u>the Enemy</u>, words have caused *greater destruction* in our families, communities, and churches than virtually any other force around. That's why we must pray against these **attacks** on our language and ask God instead to *filter everything* that is said, especially by <u>His children</u>, using a:

1. Muzzle of LOVE. (1 Corinthians 13:1)

- a. **NOTE:** The first **filter** that must *censor* everything that we say is that of <u>love</u>. If the syllables we speak do not convey **God's message** of *love and acceptance* then they have <u>no business</u> leaving our lips. **The lost** in our lives do not need *further exposure* to the <u>evil hatred</u> of this world, they already have enough of that inside of their **hearts** and **heads**. Instead they need consistent exposure to the *love*, *life*, and *light* of God that He has chosen to share with this world through <u>His people</u>. In addition, God's children need **consistent reminders** of the love of *their Father*, and who better to do so than their <u>brother or sister</u>? The Enemy **hates** this ability of ours to *spread love* with a <u>simple word</u>, so He aims to **twist** and **manipulate** all that is said to our *detriment* and *destruction*. Thankfully, the <u>love of God</u> **in us** can, will, and *has overcome* <u>every scheme</u> of the Evil one yesterday, today, and tomorrow! (1 Cor. 16:14; Jer. 31:3; Rom. 8:31-37)
 - i. For Ex. "Lord God, thank You for the love with which You spoke into my heart and changed my life for all of eternity. Please fill us today with that same love, completely covering all aspects of our being until it overflows into our every word. Filter our tongues, Father, muzzling our mouths with Your love so that if any unloving word should try to escape it would be trapped and silenced. Defeat every attempt of the Enemy to twist and manipulate our speech, overwhelming their schemes by the power of Your love in us."
 - 1. REMEMBER: Real love hates evil and treasures good. (Romans 12:9)

2. Bridle of TRUTH. (Ephesians 4:15)

a. **NOTE:** In a world of **half-truths** and clever **deceptions**, what the world needs more of is what many would consider to be "brutal" honesty. What is more brutal, though, are the **lies** constantly *told* and *believed* that are keeping people in bondage and robbing them

of **the freedom** Christ died for. Remember, our Enemy is the *Father of lies* and by his <u>falsehoods</u> he aims to **steal**, **kill**, and **destroy** all of the *goodness of God* in our lives. Normally targeted at the destruction of <u>relationships</u>, he will often aim to **deceive** a *child of God* then use them to <u>spread this deception</u>. To be **on guard** against these strategies, we must *hold tightly* to the truth in <u>every occasion</u>, internally and externally, asking God to continually **lead us** into *all truth* and to <u>expose the lies</u> for what they are. (<u>Proverbs 34:12-13</u>; <u>John 8:32</u>; <u>2 Corinthians 11:13-14</u>; <u>John 16:13</u>)

- i. For Ex. "Dear Lord, thank You for Your truth that sets us free and continually rescues us from the chains of bondage that try to retake their former hold. Fill us with and cleanse us by this truth so that nothing we feel, think, or say would be tainted by the lies of our flesh, this world, or Satan's forces. May Your honesty and integrity lead, guide, and direct every word that is said, keeping us far from all deceit and deception. Holy Spirit, lead us deeper into all truth and bridle our tongue by it, so that should we attempt to say anything dishonestly it would remain stuck in our mouths."
 - 1. **REMEMBER:** The **truth** is ALWAYS *better*. (2 Corinthians 13:8)

3. Guard of <u>DISCERNMENT</u>. (<u>Proverbs 18:20</u>)

- a. **NOTE:** Just because something comes from a **heart of love** and contains *nothing but truth* does not mean that it is always the right thing to say. **Timing** and **presentation** matter, saying the right thing, at the right time, and in the right way. As wonderfully complex as human beings are, this can be a difficult feat to accomplish on our best days without any sort of **outside interference**. Unfortunately, though, we live in a world of constant interference by our Enemy whose goal is to take this amazingly **loving truth** that can set us free and twist it to cause additional **damage** and **harm**. To prevent this from happening and to allow for the effective delivery of God's good word, we must pray for a **guard of discernment** to watch over our lips to prevent any idle world from slipping by at the wrong time or in the wrong way. (James 1:26; Prov. 15:28; Prov. 5:2)
 - i. For Ex. "Father God, thank You for giving wisdom to the foolish and knowledge to the ignorant. Please grant to us today the ability to know not only what to say, but when and how to say it well. Teach us to watch our words carefully, exercising discernment so that we might limit the enemy's ability to harm others. Guard our every word, keeping us from saying anything that is not necessary to the growth and advancement of Your kingdom and domain.
 - REMEMBER: A poorly timed word can sting <u>almost as badly</u> as a hateful lie. (<u>Proverbs 15:23</u>)

Questions for Reflection:

- What do your words reveal about the love in your heart?
 - As God to **remove** anything *blocking* or *diverting* His love in You from being expressed.
- Do you ever **excuse** a *small lie* or *partial truth* that was said with "pure" motives?
 - Much like a deadly cancer, lies never stay small. Deal with them <u>early and often</u> to prevent the spread.
- How often do you **mean well** and speak *the truth* but end up saying the wrong thing anyway?
 - Ask for wisdom, discernment, and shrewdness and practice pausing before speaking.
