

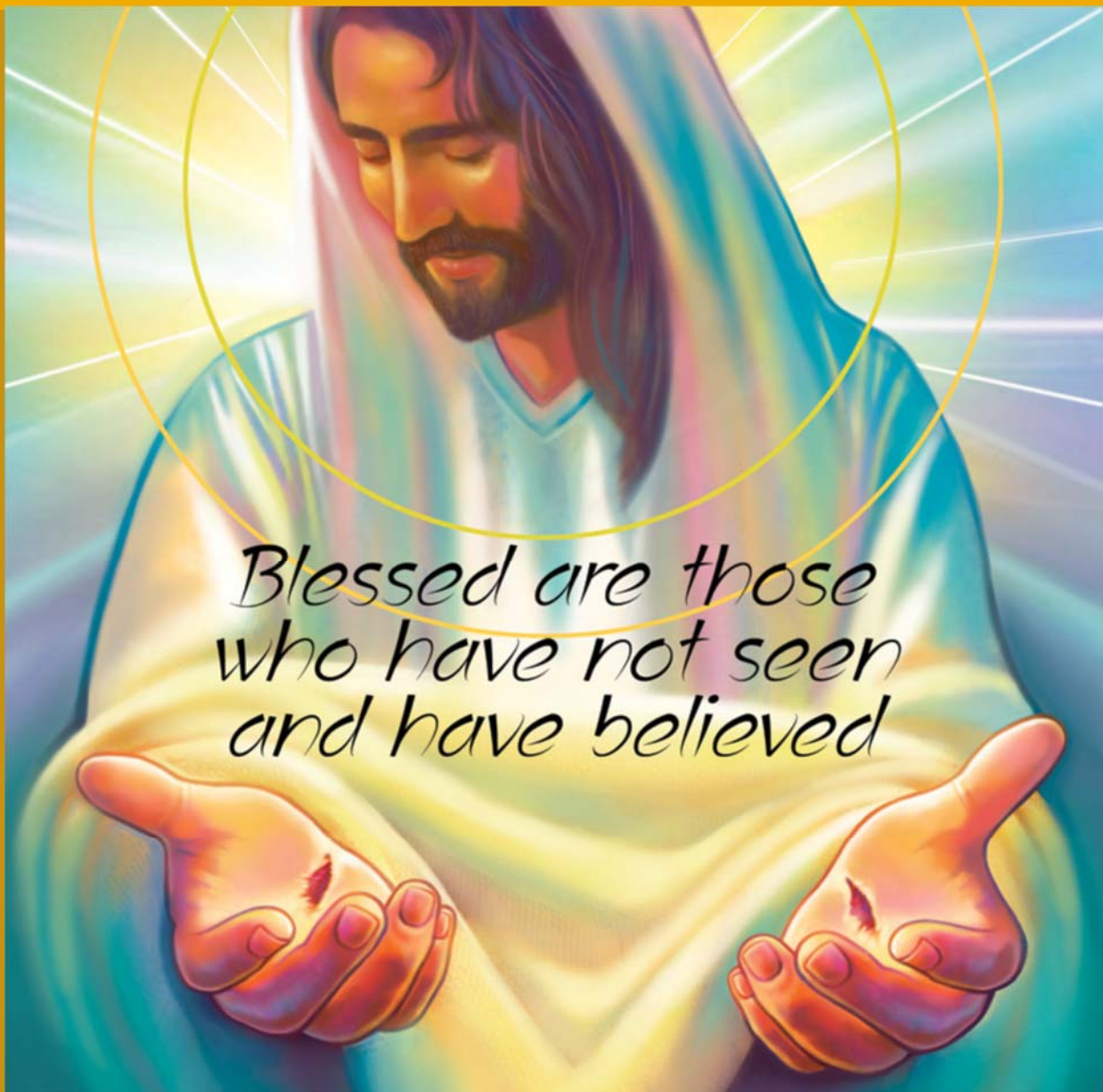

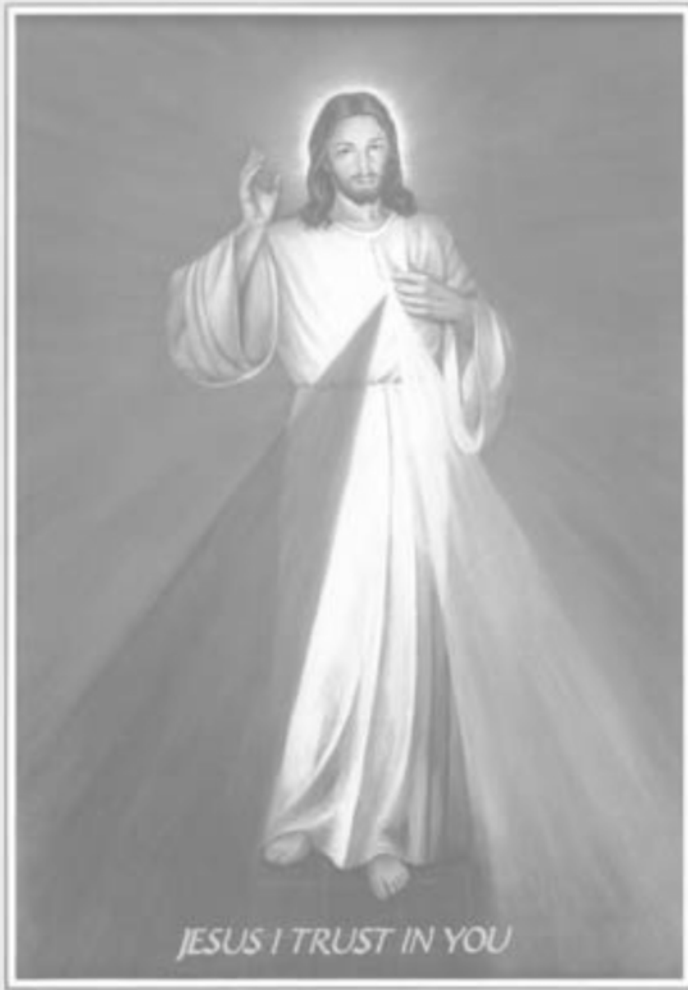
### Communion for Sick and Homebound Parishioners
