


Verse 1: Choir and Congregation

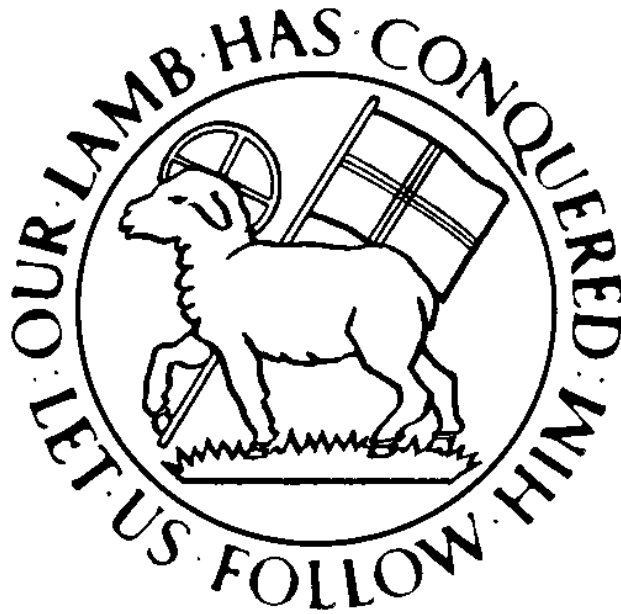
