2021 EASTER SUNRISE SERVICES

Christ Moravian Church will hold a Sunrise Service at 9:00 AM with the Easter Liturgy and Band on the lawn on Academy Street.

Friedberg Moravian Church will conduct its usual, in-person, Easter Service this year. The inside part of the service will begin at 10:30 AM. Attendees to the inside part will need to pre-register by going to the Friedberg website. Registration will not open for a while. Around 11:00 AM, the congregation will exit the sanctuary for the Easter Liturgy. The congregation will process to Friedberg's God's Acre.

Mizpah Moravian Church will have a traditional Easter Sunrise service this year, which will start around 6:45 AM.

Olivet Moravian Church will have an Easter Sunrise Service at 6:45 AM in God's Acre. We will also be able to have drive-in at our service. Social distance will be maintained along with all other social requirements.

Kernersville Moravian Church will have a sunrise service starting at 6:45 AM. We will only have the outside portion, so we will be on the graveyard to begin the service.

Salem Congregation - Recognizing the continued challenges and risks associated with COVID-19, the Board of Elders of the Salem Congregation announces that the 2021 Easter Sunrise Service will again be live-streamed from the interior of Home Moravian Church. There will be no outdoor component and attendance indoors will be restricted to the worship team. *The service will also be broadcast on moraviansunrise.org and on WXII Channel 12 television at 6:15 AM.
