The pastors, chair of Risk Management Team, and deacons we have heard back from have agreed to the following recommendation: That we do not meet for the next two weeks to be a community partner in the effort to significantly slow the spread of the coronavirus, but have a minimal team to conduct a worship service at 11 AM both Sundays to stream on Facebook live and to upload on the website by 4 PM Sunday. This service will also be available on our local Comcast TV ministry (Thur. 3 PM Chesterfield; Fri. 7:30 PM and Sun. 2 PM for Tri-Cities). This means that our Anniversary plans have been cancelled or postponed. We will reschedule our Africa Mission Team report, etc. We do encourage high participation in our online worship. Stayed tuned for plans for beyond March 29. We encourage members and attendees to continue to send in your offerings since our expenses are ongoing. Either mail your offerings to P.O. We have scheduled this year's VBS for July 20-24. Please put this on your calendar if you plan to serve or bring children. Let VBS Director Joyce Tucker know if you would be willing to serve in this year's VBS. It is a vital outreach ministry for our church.

We still need more volunteers to sign up to keep our lawn mowed. If you would be willing to serve on a grass cutting team, please sign up on the bulletin board. You should only need to donate 2-4 hours every 4-6 weeks. Only those 16 and up should sign up (ages 13-15 should only work under the supervision of a parent).

Please continue to give to our annual emphasis in support of North American missionary work as Southern Baptists. In addition to prayer support, our Mission Board is highly dependent upon the annual Annie Armstrong Offering for North American missions, for this offering supplies about one half of their operating budget. Our goal is \$7,500. 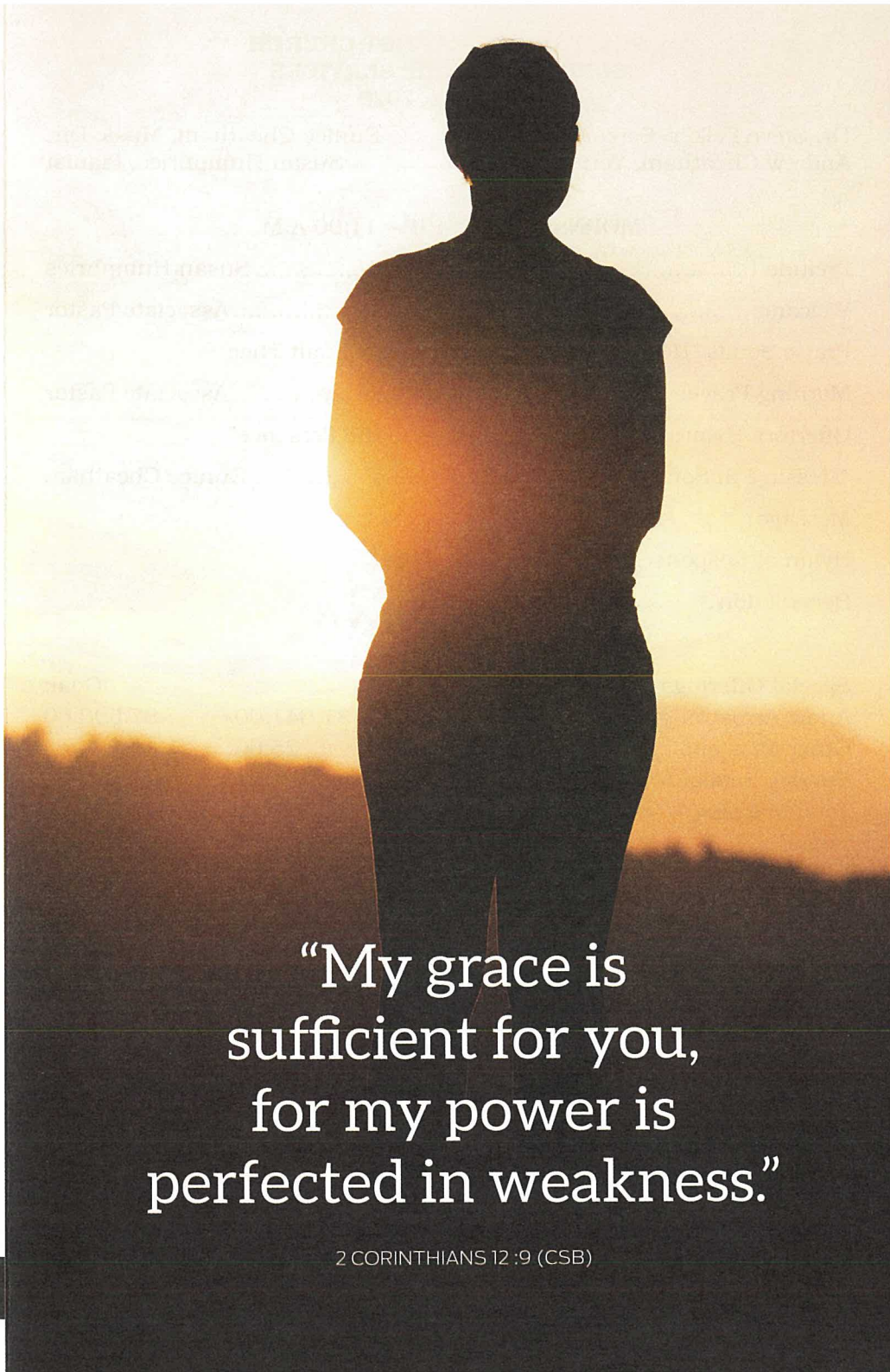
