The food pantry is in need of these items: peanut butter, jelly, canned corn, canned fruit, and canned meat items such as ravioli, beef stew, etc. Thank you.

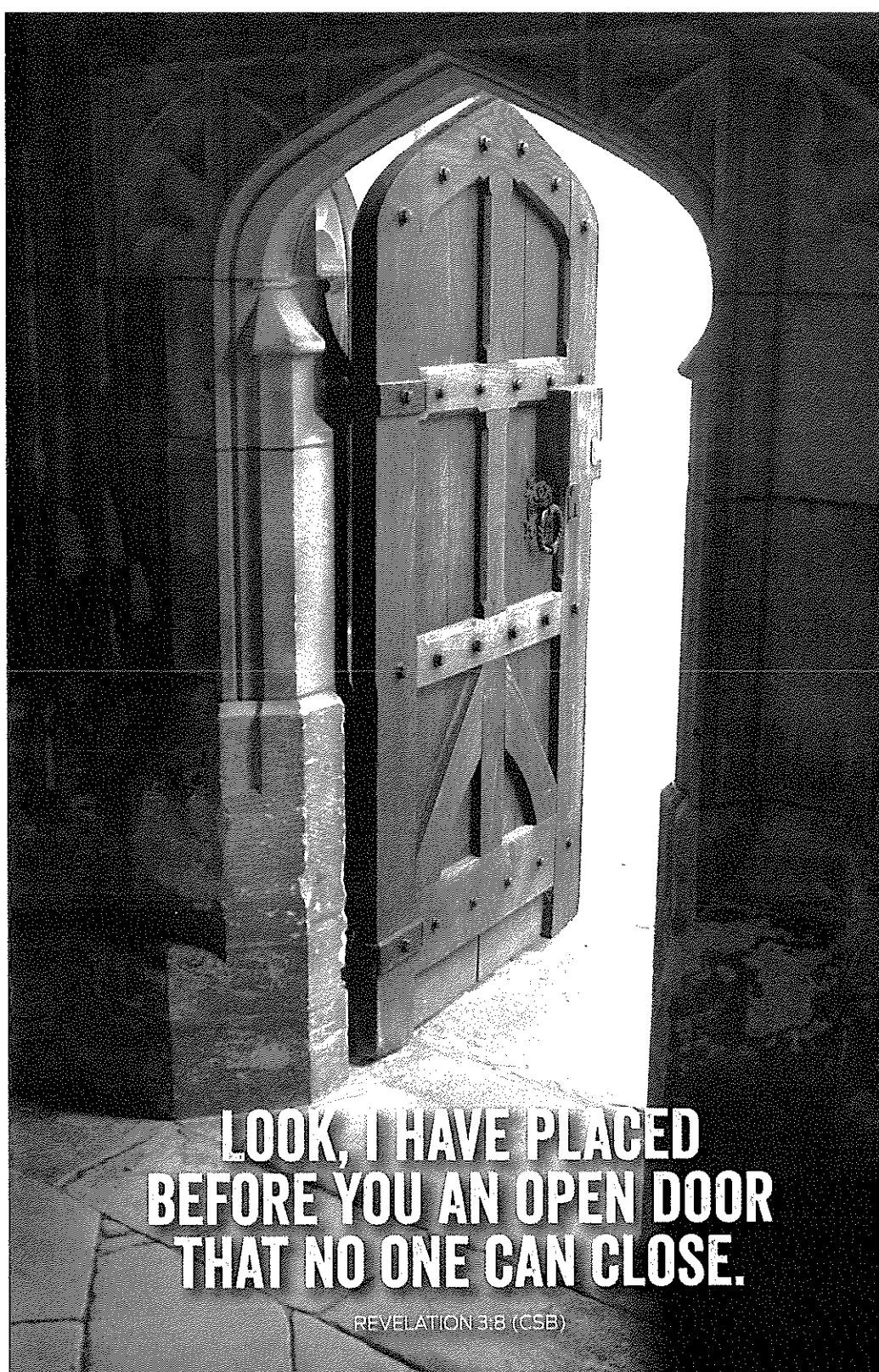
Early voting has begun for the Governor's race and other elected offices. We encourage you to participate in this year's election!
