Grilled chicken, hot dogs, bread and drinks will be provided by the Church and the Hospitality Committee. It is *suggested* that those with last names of A-M bring a vegetable, and N-Z bring fruit or dessert. We will have our evening worship service after the meal at 6:00 p.m. with a mini concert by our Music Ministry. Feel free to invite guests, especially those who need a church home. We hope you will be present for this opportunity for good food and Christian fellowship. If you plan to come it will be really helpful if you sign up in response to the email we will send out, or by signing up on the bulletin board by Wednesday, Aug. 15. This will give us a better idea of how much food to buy. One new addition to Kehukee is the Prayer Garden built by an Eagle Scout as a project. 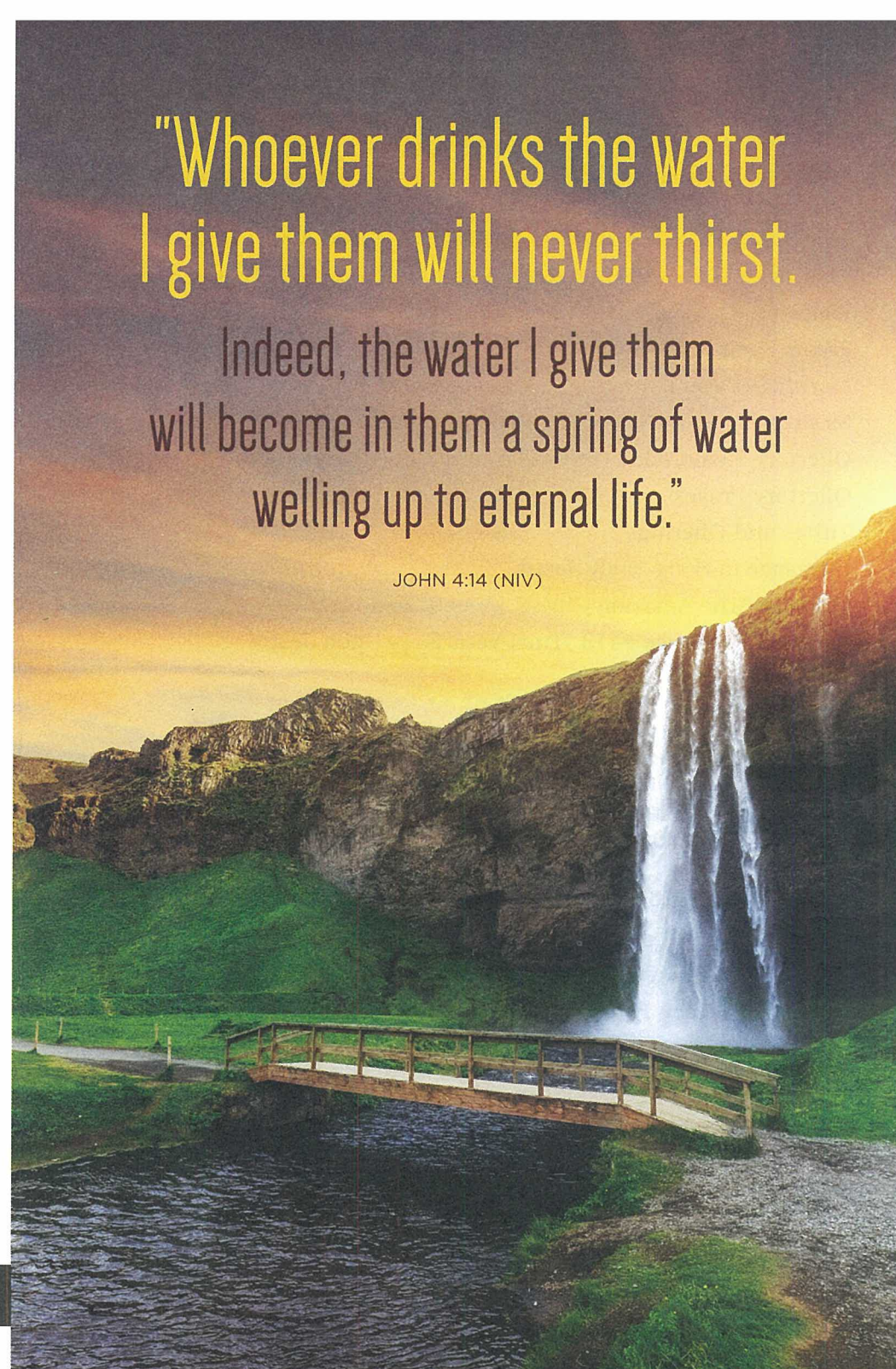
