



New Parent Admission Process

1. Set up a meeting to tour Gateway Academy. *If an IEP exists, you must first submit the IEP to GA's administration before setting up tour.*
2. Complete an online application found on our website under the admissions tab.
3. Set up a date and time for the child to:
 - Complete an admission test (for children entering 2nd through 8th grade). The fee for testing is \$50 for the 1st child, and \$25 for each additional child. *Bring report card and state test scores from current school on testing day.*
 - Students entering pre-k, kindergarten, and 1st grade must shadow for half a day. It is optional for students entering grades 2 – 5.
4. Parent is informed that their child meets the necessary requirements academically and socially. Parent will now either 1) submit a completed registration application and fees online or 2) apply for tuition assistance online.
5. For parents that complete the registration process, a student enrollment agreement will follow and must be signed. For parents applying for tuition assistance, registration and enrollment agreement will be submitted after an award has been granted.

If tuition assistance is necessary, you may apply for assistance before registering your child. Tuition assistance is solely based on financial need.
