### **What is the ECCA?**

The Educational Choice for Children Act (ECCA) creates a federal tax credit of up to \$1,700 that eligible taxpayers can designate to qualified scholarship-granting organizations like Gateway Academy. Governor Hochul has announced her intention to sign the companion state legislation, with designations opening January 1, 2027.

### **Does this cost me extra money?**

No. The ECCA redirects up to \$1,700 of taxes you already owe. Rather than that money going to the federal government, you direct it to GA. You pay the same amount in taxes — the destination changes.

### **Is my pledge binding?**

No. This pledge is a non-binding statement of intent. GA will collect your information now and contact you starting January 1, 2027, with everything you need to complete your official designation.

### **How is the scholarship amount calculated?**

Our goal is 1,000 donors each pledging up to \$1,700, generating up to \$1.7 million in total scholarship funding for GA students.

### **Who is eligible to participate?**

Any individual with an applicable federal tax liability may be eligible. GA will provide detailed eligibility guidance once the final regulations are published. Submit your pledge and our team will follow up with personalized information.
