To make an adult, child or youth reservation, you can do the following: call the church office at 850-243-3163; email Julie at jhaley@fbcfwb.org; sign up in Bible Study (Sign-up sheets will be in the Bible Study folders every Sunday. Class directors need to share this with their class and be sure to put the sign-up sheet back in the Bible Study folder.); or sign up on Wednesday evening, for the following Wednesday each week, when you pay for your meal. If you are unable to come to the Wednesday meal (going out of town, sick, etc.), you need to cancel your reservation by calling the church office. Sign up/cut-off time is 12:00 p.m. every Tuesday.**
- **FIRST ESSENTIALS: 5:00 p.m. (Childcare provided): "The Baptist Faith & Message"-Fellowship Hall.** This class will be a study of the articles of faith adhered to by the Southern Baptist Convention, or basically, "what Southern Baptists distinctly believe." The study is broken up into 18 lessons. It will be taught by Jim Hale, Lee Hale, and Adam Babcock. The theology taught in this class will help in lesson preparation, teaching, and in daily Christian witnessing as we take time to study what we believe about God's plan of salvation in the Bible. The cost is \$8 for the study guide. **"How God Makes Men"**. This class will be a men's study on 10 key men from the Bible and how they uniquely impacted their world by following God. It will be taught by Phillip Cowart and Joshua Manning and will meet in **M-203**. The curriculum is set into 10 chapters, each based on a Biblical character: Abraham, Moses, Joseph, Gideon, David, Solomon, Nehemiah, Job, Peter, and Paul. The cost is \$10 for the study guide. **"Jesus Among Secular Gods: Confronting the Claims of Cultures"**. This class will be a study on apologetics, looking at the claims of Jesus versus the claims of the secular age we live in. It will be taught by Beth Wimberly and will meet in **M-201**. The curriculum is set into 6 sessions: Be Prepared, Atheism and Scientism, Pluralism, Humanism and Relativism, Hedonism, and Conversations that Count. The cost is \$10 for the study guide. **Children's Choir. Choir Suite.** A fun time for children in K4-5th grade-Led by Amy Espy under the direction of Rev. Jeff Keeman. **Youth Choir.** Sunday Mornings at 8:30 a.m. in the Sanctuary-led by Rev. Jeff Keeman.
