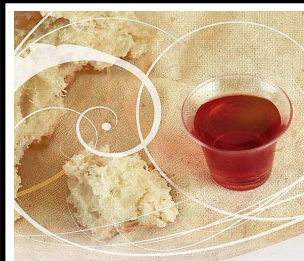

- **Summer Missions Internship -- Nations Church Planting Network:** Our church supports Brett & Lyuba West under this NAMB-sponsored effort, and they have passed along this opportunity for which the Missions Committee is offering partial payment and support. This Summer Intern Program is for High School Seniors and college students who are passionate about Christian ministry (ages 17-25). It is designed to help those who want to grow in ministry skills such as witnessing, making disciples, church planting, International peoples outreach, teaching, and Christian leadership. Weekly instruction and hands on experience are emphasized. The Summer Intern Program will last 8 weeks from June 1 through August 1, 2018. Paid expenses include housing, utilities, food, and all ministry-related expenses. Expenses not included are personal travel and recreation, personal items such as cell phones, clothes, toiletries, snacks, etc., initial travel to and from Houston, Texas. Interns will live in an apartment unit provided by a ministry partner of Nations Church Houston: men sharing one apartment and ladies sharing another apartment. Total cost is \$1500, including an intern-paid \$200 non-refundable deposit due May 1. FBC-FWB Missions will pay \$750.
