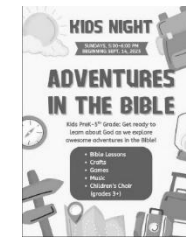
SUNDAY EVENING ACTIVITIES

NICENE CREED

We believe in one God, the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth, and of all things visible and invisible.

FIRST THING MINISTRY (from Rev. Mark Miller)

First Thing is a ministry to Middle School students in the CSD supported by local evangelical churches of various denominations. Once a week, students gather to enjoy donuts and hear a Biblical message before school starts. There is a rotation of speakers from different churches. I do it at Oakridge Middle once per month and have also filled in at Clover Middle. Approximately 30 students per Middle School attend on a weekly basis.

First Thing is governed by a board that includes both ARP pastors (Rev. Benjamin Glaser of Bethany and me) in Clover. The ARP Churches and Lake Wylie Christian Assembly are the biggest church supporters of the ministry at the present time.

First Thing uses financial support to cover the costs of insurance, tee shirts for students, and Bibles. All the work is strictly voluntary.
