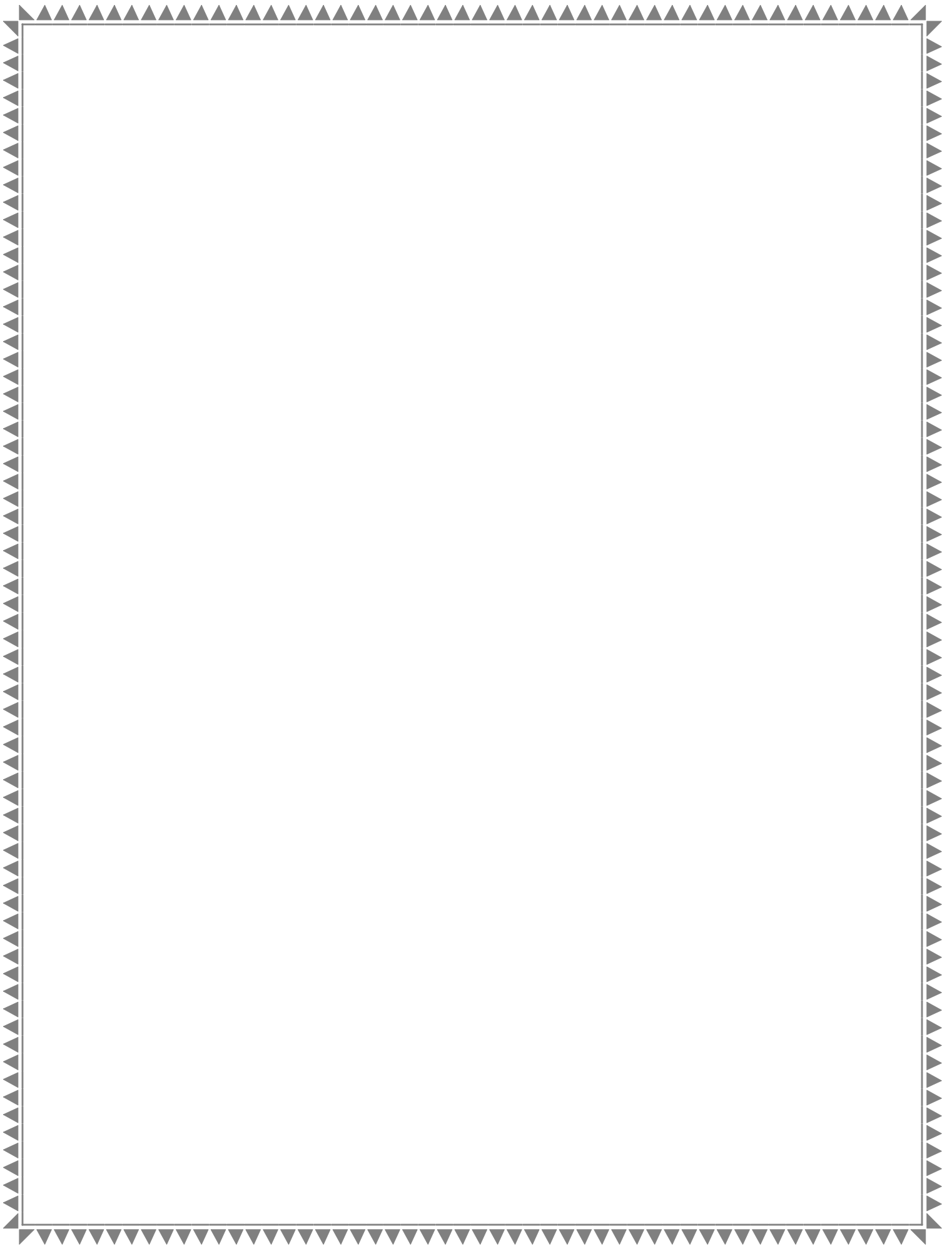

- **Sunday School Lead Teacher** – Prepare and teach provided lessons; build positive relationships with children and parents.
- **Sunday School Assistant** – Assist lead teacher with class lessons, build positive relationships with children and parents.
- **Registration Desk** – Greet families, welcome new families, assist with check in.
- **Nursery** – Care and share the love of Jesus with children ages birth – walkers.

- **Small Group Leader** – Guide students by leading Bible studies, serving projects, and events with a small group of students.
- **Sunday School Leader** – Lead teaching and discussion in Sunday school.
- **Second Adult** – Make sure Sunday school classes, groups and events adhere to Safe Sanctuary policy by being present. There's no teaching or leading requirements; their main priority is to keep students safe.
- **Host Team** – Work alongside students to make sure everyone who attends a Fusion event feels accepted and welcomed.
