Now is a great time to join a Wednesday night Bible! All classes meet at 6:30 pm.



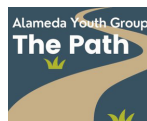

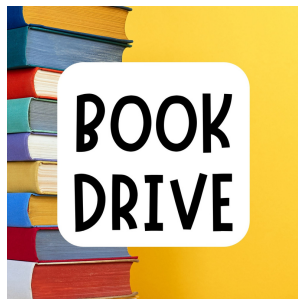


Sermon Series
