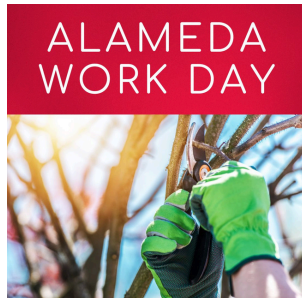
Sermon Series
