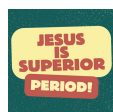

Wednesday night Bible classes will resume for the Fall on **Sep 2**.

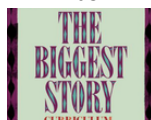


Randy Johns will lead our all-ages adult class titled, "Jesus Is Superior--Period!" A Study of the Book of Hebrews

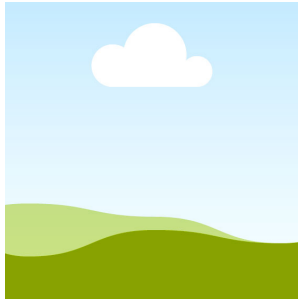
