Wednesday night Bible classes resume for the Fall quarter this Wednesday, **September 3!** All classes meet at 6:30 pm.



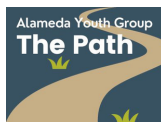
Randy Johns will be leading our all-ages adult class titled, "Chaos! A Study of 1 Corinthians."
