- Fulfill tasks or assignments related to CCYM activities
- Be willing to voice ideas and assume responsibilities for change and improvement
- Assist with leadership and attend CCYM sponsored events
- Recruit CCYM members
- Keep your church and district informed about CCYM events
- Support your district by attending events and meetings
- Lead and pray with youth, small groups and adults
- Pray regularly for you local church, CCYM, NTC and the global church
- Stay in touch and regularly communicate with adult leaders and other CCYM members. CHECK AND ANSWER YOUR EMAIL, RETURN PHONE CALLS, ETC!!!
- Act, speak and dress modestly and appropriately. Especially while participating in any and all CCYM, Conference and local church events.
