### **Reopening**

- We will begin live Sunday services at 9am on Sunday, July 12.
- Service attendance does not require pre-registration, but know that we will allow a maximum of 200 people to attend live.
- We will continue to host our services live on YouTube for those who wish to be with us online.
- Until further notice, we will not have Sunday School, nor will we have Sunday children's/youth programming other than what will be in our 9am service.
- We will have our nursery and Rm 106 available for families with small children.

## Office Hours

- Starting Thursday, July 9, the church office will be open from 9:00 - 4:00 on Thursdays.
- If you require a meeting with any of our staff please contact them directly to schedule a meeting.

## Guidelines

Here is a list of the major precautions and recommendations we will be taking. The purpose behind our guidelines is not to live in fear of COVID-19, but to show love and consideration for all of our LifePoint family, particularly those most susceptible to the COVID-19 virus.

- ***If you are not feeling well (cough or fever) and/or know that you have been exposed to the COVID-19 virus in the last 14 days, we ask that you worship online from home and contact us so that we can pray for you.***
- Face-masks will be worn by all persons in the building, age 3 and older.
- A limited number of face masks will be available for those who do not have their own
- The Worship Center will be limited to a maximum capacity of 200 persons, including the balcony.
- Signage on East and West doors will indicate outside entrances and exits.
- South doors will be locked, and we ask that they not be used.
- Doors will be held or propped open to prevent attendees from having to touch them (weather permitting).
- X's on the floor of the Welcome Center will mark standing locations while waiting to be seated in the Worship Center.
- Our seating in the Welcome Center is arranged to accommodate social distancing. You will be directed to a seat by an usher.

- Attendees will be dismissed from the Worship Center by row, from back to front.
- Following the service, please exit the building promptly. We encourage conversations to be held outside the building, respecting social distancing.
- We request that you refrain from handshaking, hugs, or other physical touch.
- Offering should be placed in the secure slot at the Welcome Center in the foyer.
- Signage throughout the building will remind attendees of safety practices.
- We will have restrooms and door handles cleaned before each service.
- We will make available numerous hand sanitizing stations throughout the open areas of the building.
- There will be limited access to public spaces in the building in order to minimize exposure.
- We encourage regular hand washing.
- Live Streaming of services will continue to be available for all who are not attending in person.
- **If someone, after visiting our building, tests positive for COVID-19, the office will inform the congregation via email.**

It is our desire to ensure the best and safest experience for all of our LifePoint family and guests. As we do begin to meet in person again, we encourage you to be flexible, patient, and have a willingness to sacrifice for others. The precautions we take are not out of fear but are a reflection of the sacrifice and love of Christ for those who are vulnerable.
