- At the close of the first year's work, October 1, 1969, there were 89 members, 117 enrolled in Sunday School, 73 enrolled in Church Training, a group of 9 deacons elected to serve for the coming year, and a budget of \$49,075.00 was adopted. As of October 1, 1970, there were 120 members, 139 enrolled in Sunday School, 79 enrolled in Church Training, and programs started in W.M.U., Brotherhood, and Music.
- The first VBS was held August 4-8, 1969 with 71 enrolled.
- All Hail the Power and Take My Life and Let It Be were sung in the dedication service on October 18, 1970.
