Important Info

- Costume closet will be open on Set Build day, Mar 1 and Wed, March 4th from 4-6.
- Nursery open 15 minutes before practice for ages 0-4.

SHOW DAYS

- Kitchen open @ 5:15 for ushers, greeters, & security; 5:30 for cast & crew.
- Saturday is the final show. Dinner served AFTER the set strike.
- Be dressed and ready in the Kids Church room by 6:30 for devo and prayer.
- Nursery open @ 6:30 for 0-4 years; 1:30 on Saturday.
- Child care for 5+ AFTER miracles scene.

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IMPORTANT INFO

SET UP/TEAR DOWN

- We will unload the Easter trailer and create the set on March 1st at 2PM.
- There is plenty to do for everyone, so please come spend this day together transforming the sanctuary and bonding as a cast.
- Part of the set up will be bringing extra chairs down to the sanctuary.
- We will strike the set after the last performance on Saturday before we eat.

REHEARSAL

- Please try your best to be at every rehearsal, especially if you are a disciple or have a speaking role.
- Sunday Rehearsals will start at 5PM and Wednesday at 6PM. These usually last around 2 hours.
- Rehearsals will be as close to performance level as they can be. We will have lights, fog, darkness and other special effects. Please, do not let children be running around unsupervised because we don't want them to get hurt or scared.
- Nursery for 0-4 will be available during rehearsals beginning 15 minutes before start time.

COSTUMES

- Costumes are located in the Kid's Room.
- Costume closet will be open starting on set build day and the following Wednesday from 4-6. Please try to get costumes on one of these days if possible. The costume closet volunteers will assist you in choosing your costume. Please try to get your costume as soon as you can.
- No watches or glasses (if possible) during performances. If you are wearing pants underneath your costume, please make sure that they are not sticking out.
- If your hair is dark you do not have to wear a headdress. If you have lighter hair (blonde or red) please wear a headdress. If your hair shows a little bit it is fine. If your hair is not a natural color (purple, green, blue, etc.) please cover all of it.
- There will be assigned dressing rooms where your costume will stay. After performances, please neatly hang it up in your dressing room. You are free to take it home and wash it if you want to.
- After the last performance, check your costume in with Mrs. Karen before hanging it back on the racks and we will take care of washing them.
- Each cast member is responsible for their own props. If you use a prop as part of your costume in the performance make sure you know exactly where it is for the next night.
- If you see a prop setting around, don't move it unless it belongs to you.

PERFORMANCE NIGHTS

Meals

- Dinner will be served each night before the play followed by a time of devo and prayer.
- Kitchen opens @ 5:15 for ushers, greeters, & security; 5:30 for cast & crew.
- Dinner will be AFTER the set strike following the final show on Saturday.
- Keep all food and drink in the Kids Church area.

Seating

- Cast members can reserve seats for their family
 - All sign ups for this must run through the church office. There will only be 15 seats available per performance.
 - Family who have been signed up on reserved seating sheet will enter through Noah's Ark doors between 5:30-5:45 and wait there to be ushered to their reserved seats. (12:30-12:45 on Saturday)
 - Seats are first come first serve basis. Doors open an hour before show starts, but a line will start forming before that.
 - Encourage your family to attend Dress Rehearsal.
- Reserved Group Seating
 - Minimum of 10 for group reservations.
 - Must call the church office for reservations and include organization name, how many in the group, contact name and number.
 - Reserved seating groups will enter through Noah's Ark doors between 5:30-5:45 and wait to be ushered to their seats. (12:30-12:45 on Saturday)

Childcare

- Nursery available (0-4 yrs) during show nights starting @ 6:30 & 1:30 on Saturday.
- Childcare 5-12 will be provided after the Miracles scene. They need to change clothes and be walked to 414 where they will stay until the play is over. They must be checked in and out by a guardian.
- Kids or teenagers should not be wandering around backstage/in the halls at any point during performance. Kids must be with their parents or in childcare in the gym. Teenagers must remain in the play or in the Kid's Room. Do not be wandering the halls or going into classrooms.

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Final cast list will be posted within a week.

-If you have any ideas for the play, please refrain from interrupting rehearsal. Your thoughts and ideas are important to us, so write them down and wait to talk to Pastor Alex or Krystle after rehearsal.

-Once doors are open to the public do not go past Heritage Hall doors in costume.

-Cast members park in the gravel lot by the dumpster and come in 414 doors under awning.

-Prayer with those wanting to be saved is in the Sanctuary after the show.
