THREE APPS GOD USES TO HELP ME CHANGE:
App #1 God uses the, the Word of God, to change us.
2 Timothy 3:16 (NIV) All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, 17 so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.
App #2 The changes us.
Romans 8:11 (Ph) Nevertheless once the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead lives within you he will, by that same Spirit, bring to your whole being new strength and vitality.
App #3 God uses to change us.
