TWO THINGS TO FORGET IN ORDER TO FOLLOW PAUL: #1 Your ____. Acts 7:58 (NIV) dragged him out of the city and began to stone him. Meanwhile, the witnesses laid their coats at the feet of a young man named Saul.

Luke 9:62 (NIV) Jesus replied, "No one who puts a hand to the plow and looks back is fit for service in the kingdom of God."

Step #3: Deep	:	focus	on	the	future.

Philippians 3:13 ...and straining toward what is ahead,

- 1. Corinthians 9:24 (NIV) Do you not know that in a race all the runners run, but only one gets the prize? Run in such a way as to get the prize.
- 2. Corinthians 5:9 (NIV) So we make it our goal to please him,

Step #4: Unabashed : I finish strong.

Philippians 3:14 (NIV) I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus.

Galatians 6:9 (NIV) Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up.
