Prepare for Sunday's message

Before you start, read the introduction to 2 Peter in your Bible. If your Bible doesn't have one, you can read this one - <https://www.biblica.com/resources/scholar-notes/niv-study-bible/intro-to-2-peter/>

Read 2 Peter 1:1-11

Read 2 Peter 1:1-4 again

Identify the keywords of 2 Peter 1:1-4

Look up those keywords, maybe using a Bible resource like the NET Bible (<https://netbible.org/bible/2+Peter+1>)

Read 2 Peter 1:1-4 again

Use 2 Peter 1:1-4 as a prayer guide (for example, verse 1. "Thank you Father for giving me the gift of faith. Thank you Jesus for applying your righteousness to my account. Father, I pray I'd be more aware of my standing in your eyes." and then move on to verse 2)

How does it make you feel to know that you have an equal standing with people like the apostle Peter?

How would you define grace?

How would you describe peace?

What do you believe are the most "wicked awesome" promises of God?
