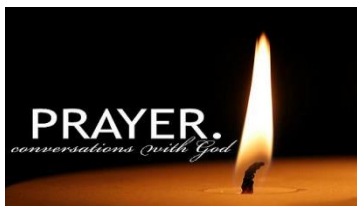
JAM at First Place
