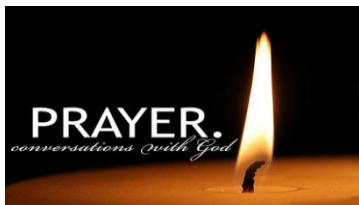

In the future the table can be used by individuals or groups when selling items for Missions that will need to be coordinated by Susan in the Office.

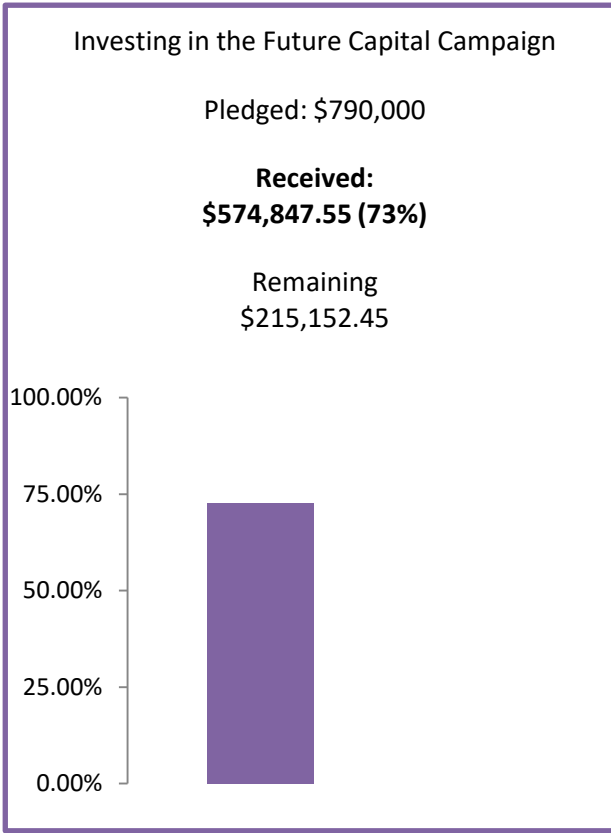
