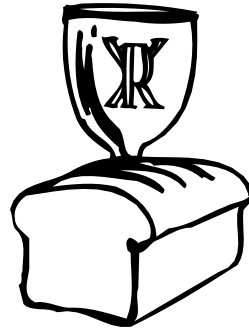
How Beautiful
