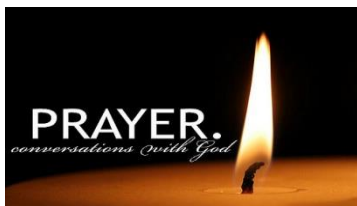

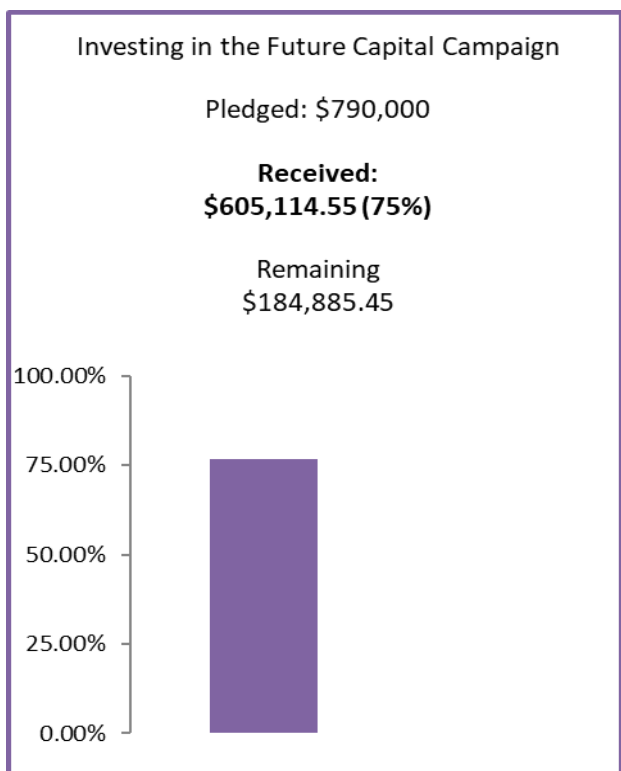
There is an article about gluten in food. It answers questions about gluten in our diet.
