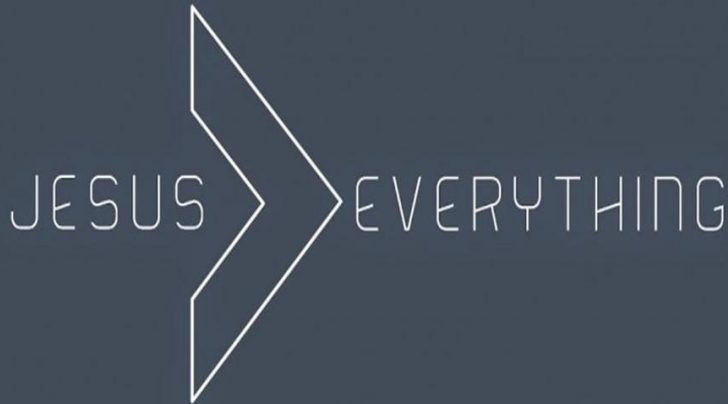

FIRST PLACE FOOD PANTRY OPEN HOUSE

First Place Food Pantry started as an outreach of First United Methodist Church in Troy, Ohio in January 2001. It has grown and expanded beyond all imagination. It is now an independent 501C3 organization serving Troy residents in their critical food need.

The generosity of our community has been significant. Food donations from churches, individuals, businesses and our participation in Shared Harvest Food Bank have been extremely useful in allowing us to provide services at a very low cost. However, we have a greater need for funds to support the operating expenses.

Please join us so you can see and experience, how in 2017, the First Place Food Pantry served 18,225 individuals in food crisis at a cost of about \$3.35 /person for a month supply of food.

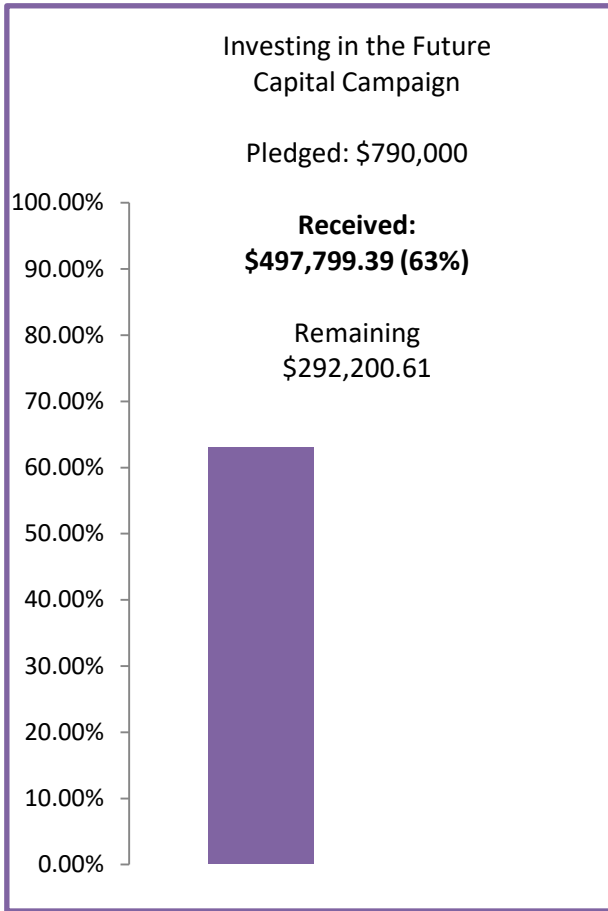
