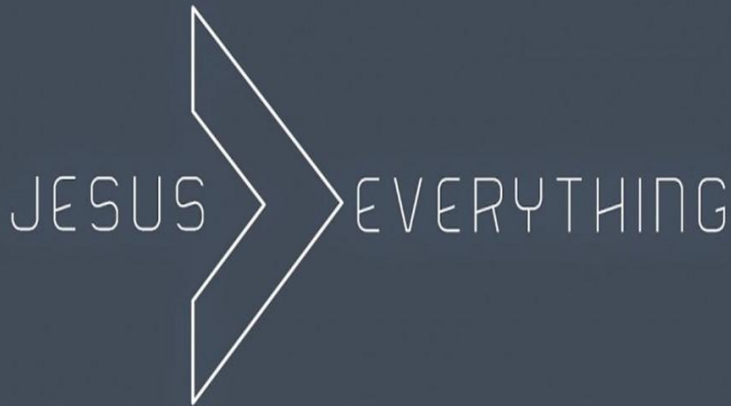

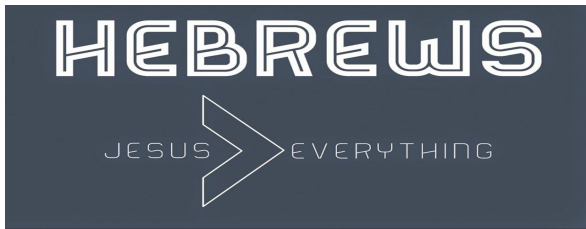

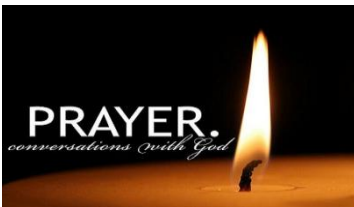
Trunk or Treat
