New Recombinant Zoster Shingles

There is a new shingles vaccine available. This vaccine was approved by FDA in 2017 for prevention of shingles. In clinical trials, it was more than 90% effective in preventing shingles. The vaccine is given in two doses, 2-6 months apart, they are recommended for adults 50 or older. There is more information available in the gathering room or at First Place concerning other questions you may have and check with your personal physician.

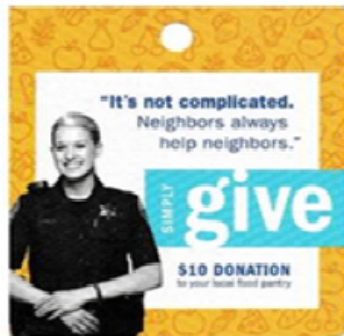
