



## ***Sola Scriptura:* The Bible alone is our supreme authority.**

### **2 Timothy 3:15-17**

<sup>15</sup> and that from childhood you have known the sacred writings which are able to give you the wisdom that leads to salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus. <sup>16</sup> All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness; <sup>17</sup> so that the man of God may be adequate, equipped for every good work.

### **Acts 17:11**

<sup>11</sup> Now these were more noble-minded than those in Thessalonica, for they received the word with great eagerness, examining the Scriptures daily to see whether these things were so.

### **2 Peter 1:19-21**

<sup>19</sup> So we have the prophetic word made more sure, to which you do well to pay attention as to a lamp shining in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star arises in your hearts. <sup>20</sup> But know this first of all, that no prophecy of Scripture is a matter of one's own interpretation, <sup>21</sup> for no prophecy was ever made by an act of human will, but men moved by the Holy Spirit spoke from God.

### **Matthew 15:1-3, 7-9**

<sup>1</sup> Then some Pharisees and scribes \*came to Jesus from Jerusalem and said, <sup>2</sup> "Why do Your disciples break the tradition of the elders? For they do not wash their hands when they eat bread." <sup>3</sup> And He answered and said to them, "Why do you yourselves transgress the commandment of God for the sake of your tradition?"

<sup>7</sup> You hypocrites, rightly did Isaiah prophesy of you:

<sup>8</sup> "THIS PEOPLE HONORS ME WITH THEIR LIPS,  
BUT THEIR HEART IS FAR AWAY FROM ME.

<sup>9</sup> "BUT IN VAIN DO THEY WORSHIP ME,  
TEACHING AS DOCTRINES THE PRECEPTS OF MEN.'"

### **James 1:21**

<sup>21</sup> Therefore, putting aside all filthiness and all that remains of wickedness, in humility receive the word implanted, which is able to save your souls.

### **Revelation 22:18-19**

<sup>18</sup> I testify to everyone who hears the words of the prophecy of this book: if anyone adds to them, God will add to him the plagues which are written in this book; <sup>19</sup> and if anyone takes away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God will take away his part from the tree of life and from the holy city, which are written in this book.

# ***Sola Gratia:* God's grace alone provides and secures our salvation.**

**Man's condition and works cannot save.**

## **Ephesians 2:1-5, 12-13**

<sup>1</sup>And you were dead in your trespasses and sins, <sup>2</sup> in which you formerly walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, of the spirit that is now working in the sons of disobedience.<sup>3</sup> Among them we too all formerly lived in the lusts of our flesh, indulging the desires of the flesh and of the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, even as the rest. <sup>4</sup> But God, being rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us. <sup>5</sup> even when we were dead in our transgressions, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved)

<sup>12</sup> remember that you were at that time separate from Christ, excluded from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers to the covenants of promise, having no hope and without God in the world. <sup>13</sup> But now in Christ Jesus you who formerly were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ.

## **Isaiah 64:6**

<sup>6</sup> For all of us have become like one who is unclean,  
And all our righteous deeds are like a filthy garment;  
And all of us wither like a leaf,  
And our iniquities, like the wind, take us away.

## **Romans 3:10-20**

<sup>10</sup>as it is written,

"THERE IS NONE RIGHTEOUS, NOT EVEN ONE;

<sup>11</sup>THERE IS NONE WHO UNDERSTANDS,

THERE IS NONE WHO SEEKS FOR GOD;

<sup>12</sup>ALL HAVE TURNED ASIDE, TOGETHER THEY HAVE BECOME USELESS;

THERE IS NONE WHO DOES GOOD,

THERE IS NOT EVEN ONE."

<sup>13</sup>"THEIR THROAT IS AN OPEN GRAVE,

WITH THEIR TONGUES THEY KEEP DECEIVING,"

"THE POISON OF ASPS IS UNDER THEIR LIPS";

<sup>14</sup>"WHOSE MOUTH IS FULL OF CURSING AND BITTERNESS";

<sup>15</sup>"THEIR FEET ARE SWIFT TO SHED BLOOD,

<sup>16</sup>DESTRUCTION AND MISERY ARE IN THEIR PATHS,

<sup>17</sup>AND THE PATH OF PEACE THEY HAVE NOT KNOWN."

<sup>18</sup>"THERE IS NO FEAR OF GOD BEFORE THEIR EYES."

<sup>19</sup>Now we know that whatever the Law says, it speaks to those who are under the Law, so that every mouth may be closed and all the world may become accountable to God; <sup>20</sup> because by the works <sup>[b]</sup>of the Law no flesh will be justified in His sight; for through the Law *comes* the knowledge of sin.

### **Galatians 2:16**

<sup>16</sup> nevertheless knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the Law but through faith in Christ Jesus, even we have believed in Christ Jesus, so that we may be justified by faith in Christ and not by the works of the Law; since by the works of the Law no flesh will be justified.

### **Galatians 3:10,13**

<sup>10</sup> For as many as are of the works of the Law are under a curse; for it is written, "CURSED IS EVERYONE WHO DOES NOT ABIDE BY ALL THINGS WRITTEN IN THE BOOK OF THE LAW, TO PERFORM THEM."

<sup>13</sup> Christ redeemed us from the curse of the Law, having become a curse for us—for it is written, "CURSED IS EVERYONE WHO HANGS ON A TREE"

### **James 2:10**

<sup>10</sup> For whoever keeps the whole law and yet stumbles in one *point*, he has become guilty of all.

## **God's grace alone is the basis for salvation.**

### **Ephesians 2:5, 8-9**

<sup>5</sup> even when we were dead in our transgressions, made us alive together with Christ by grace you have been saved, .....<sup>8</sup> For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God; <sup>9</sup> not as a result of works, so that no one may boast.

### **Romans 11:6**

<sup>6</sup> But if it is by grace, it is no longer on the basis of works, otherwise grace is no longer grace.

### **Romans 5:1-2**

<sup>1</sup> Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, <sup>2</sup> through whom also we have obtained our introduction by faith into this grace in which we stand; and we exult in hope of the glory of God.

### **Romans 4:4-5**

<sup>4</sup> Now to the one who works, his wage is not credited as a favor, but as what is due. <sup>5</sup> But to the one who does not work, but believes in Him who justifies the ungodly, his faith is credited as righteousness

### **Romans 3:19, 24**

<sup>19</sup> Now we know that whatever the Law says, it speaks to those who are under the Law, so that every mouth may be closed and all the world may become accountable to God;

<sup>24</sup> being justified as a gift by His grace through the redemption which is in Christ Jesus;

### **1 Timothy 1:9**

<sup>9</sup> who has saved us and called us with a holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace which was granted us in Christ Jesus from all eternity

### **Jude 24**

<sup>24</sup> Now to Him who is able to keep you from stumbling, and to make you stand in the presence of His glory blameless with great joy.

### **Titus 3:5**

<sup>5</sup> He saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness, but according to His mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewing by the Holy Spirit

# ***Solus Christus:* Christ is our only basis of justification.**

**His once for all death, bore the full penalty and provides full forgiveness for all sins.**

## **Romans 5:9**

<sup>9</sup>Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from the wrath of God through Him.

## **Colossians 2:13-14**

<sup>13</sup> When you were dead in your transgressions and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He made you alive together with Him, having forgiven us all our transgressions, <sup>14</sup> having canceled out the certificate of debt consisting of decrees against us, which was hostile to us; and He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross.

## **1 Peter 1:18-19**

<sup>18</sup> knowing that you were not redeemed with perishable things like silver or gold from your futile way of life inherited from your forefathers, <sup>19</sup> but with precious blood, as of a lamb unblemished and spotless, *the blood* of Christ.

## **1 Peter 2:24**

<sup>24</sup> and He Himself bore our sins in His body on the cross, so that we might die to sin and live to righteousness; for by His wounds you were healed.

## **1 Peter 3:18**

<sup>18</sup> For Christ also died for sins once for all, *the just for the unjust*, so that He might bring us to God, having been put to death in the flesh, but made alive in the spirit;

## **Ephesians 1:7**

<sup>7</sup> In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of His grace.

## **Ephesians 2:13**

<sup>13</sup> But now in Christ Jesus you who formerly were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ.

## **Hebrews 9:24-26**

<sup>24</sup> For Christ did not enter a holy place made with hands, a *mere* copy of the true one, but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us; <sup>25</sup> nor was it that He would offer Himself often, as the high priest enters the holy place year by year with blood that is not his own. <sup>26</sup> Otherwise, He would have needed to suffer often since the foundation of the world; but now once at the consummation of the ages He has been manifested to put away sin by the sacrifice of Himself.

## **Hebrews 10:10-12,14-15,17**

<sup>10</sup> By this will we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all <sup>11</sup> Every priest stands daily ministering and offering time after time the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins; <sup>12</sup> but He, having offered one sacrifice for sins for all time, sat down at the right hand of God...<sup>14</sup> For by one offering He has perfected for all time those who are sanctified. <sup>15</sup> And the Holy Spirit also testifies to us; for after saying,... <sup>17</sup>"AND THEIR SINS AND THEIR LAWLESS DEEDS I WILL REMEMBER NO MORE."

### **Romans 8:1-3**

<sup>1</sup> Therefore there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. <sup>2</sup> For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has set you free from the law of sin and of death. <sup>3</sup> For what the Law could not do, weak as it was through the flesh, God *did*: sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh and *as an offering* for sin, He condemned sin in the flesh.

## **He alone is the basis of our righteousness before God.**

### **2 Corinthians 5:21**

<sup>21</sup> He made Him who knew no sin *to be* sin on our behalf, so that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

### **Philippians 3:3-9**

<sup>3</sup> for we are the *true* circumcision, who worship in the Spirit of God and glory in Christ Jesus and put no confidence in the flesh, <sup>4</sup> although I myself might have confidence even in the flesh. If anyone else has a mind to put confidence in the flesh, I far more: <sup>5</sup> circumcised the eighth day, of the nation of Israel, of the tribe of Benjamin, a Hebrew of Hebrews; as to the Law, a Pharisee; <sup>6</sup> as to zeal, a persecutor of the church; as to the righteousness which is in the Law, found blameless. <sup>7</sup> But whatever things were gain to me, those things I have counted as loss for the sake of Christ. <sup>8</sup> More than that, I count all things to be loss in view of the surpassing value of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord, for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them but rubbish so that I may gain Christ, <sup>9</sup> and may be found in Him, not having a righteousness of my own derived from *the* Law, but that which is through faith in Christ, the righteousness which *comes* from God on the basis of faith.

### **1 Corinthians 1:30-31**

<sup>30</sup> But by His doing you are in Christ Jesus, who became to us wisdom from God, and righteousness and sanctification, and redemption, <sup>31</sup> so that, just as it is written, "LET HIM WHO BOASTS, BOAST IN THE LORD."

### **Colossians 2:10**

<sup>10</sup> and in Him (Christ) you have been made complete, and He is the head over all rule and authority;

### **Romans 5:11**

<sup>11</sup> And not only this, but we also exult in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received the reconciliation.

## **He alone is the mediator and intercessor to save sinners.**

### **1 Timothy 2:4-6**

<sup>4</sup> who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth. <sup>5</sup> For there is one God, and one mediator also between God and men, the man Christ Jesus, <sup>6</sup> who gave Himself as a ransom for all, the testimony given at the proper time.

### **1 John 2:1-2**

<sup>1</sup> My little children, I am writing these things to you so that you may not sin. And if anyone sins, we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous; <sup>2</sup> and He Himself is the propitiation for our sins; and not for ours only, but also for those of the whole world.

### **Matthew 1:21**

<sup>21</sup> She will bear a Son; and you shall call His name Jesus, for He will save His people from their sins."

**Hebrews 7:25, 27**

<sup>25</sup> Therefore He is able also to save forever those who draw near to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them... <sup>27</sup> who does not need daily, like those high priests, to offer up sacrifices, first for His own sins and then for the sins of the people, because this He did once for all when He offered up Himself.

**1 Thessalonians 1:10**

<sup>10</sup> and to wait for His Son from heaven, whom He raised from the dead, *that is* Jesus, who rescues us from the wrath to come.

**1 Thessalonians 5:9**

<sup>9</sup> For God has not destined us for wrath, but for obtaining salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ,

**Acts 4:12**

<sup>12</sup> And there is salvation in no one else; for there is no other name under heaven that has been given among men by which we must be saved.

**John 14:6**

<sup>6</sup> Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me."

**Acts 5:30-31**

<sup>30</sup> The God of our fathers raised up Jesus, whom you had put to death by hanging Him on a cross. <sup>31</sup> He is the one whom God exalted to His right hand as a Prince and a Savior, to grant repentance to Israel, and forgiveness of sins.

# ***Sola Fide:* Salvation is received completely and finally through faith alone in Christ alone.**

**Salvation is fully possessed and secure in those who believe.**

## **Ephesians 2:8-9**

<sup>8</sup> For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God; <sup>9</sup> not as a result of works, so that no one may boast.

## **Acts 10:43**

Of Him all the prophets bear witness that through His name everyone who believes in Him receives forgiveness of sins.

## **Acts 16:31**

They said, "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved, you and your household."

## **Acts 2:21**

<sup>21</sup> 'AND IT SHALL BE THAT EVERYONE WHO CALLS ON THE NAME OF THE LORD WILL BE SAVED.'

## **John 3:16**

<sup>16</sup> For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life.

## **John 3:36**

<sup>36</sup> He who believes in the Son has eternal life; but he who does not obey the Son will not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him."

## **John 5:24**

Truly, truly, I say to you, he who hears My word, and believes Him who sent Me, has eternal life, and does not come into judgment, but has passed out of death into life.

## **John 6:28-29,47**

<sup>28</sup> Therefore they said to Him, "What shall we do, so that we may work the works of God?" <sup>29</sup> Jesus answered and said to them, "This is the work of God, that you believe in Him whom He has sent." ...

<sup>47</sup> Truly, truly, I say to you, he who believes has eternal life.

## **1 John 5:11-13**

<sup>11</sup> And the testimony is this, that God has given us eternal life, and this life is in His Son. <sup>12</sup> He who has the Son has the life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have the life. <sup>13</sup> These things I have written to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, so that you may know that you have eternal life.

## **Romans 3:21-22**

<sup>21</sup> But now apart from the Law *the* righteousness of God has been manifested, being witnessed by the Law and the Prophets, <sup>22</sup> even *the* righteousness of God through faith in Jesus Christ for all those who believe; for there is no distinction

## **Romans 10:2-4**

<sup>2</sup> For I testify about them that they have a zeal for God, but not in accordance with knowledge. <sup>3</sup> For not knowing about God's righteousness and seeking to establish their own, they did not subject themselves to the righteousness of God. <sup>4</sup> For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone who believes.

## **Romans 10:9, 13**

<sup>9</sup> that if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved; ... <sup>13</sup> for "Whoever will call on the name of the Lord will be saved."

### **Romans 4:3-5**

<sup>3</sup>For what does the Scripture say? "ABRAHAM BELIEVED GOD, AND IT WAS CREDITED TO HIM AS RIGHTEOUSNESS."<sup>4</sup> Now to the one who works, his wage is not credited as a favor, but as what is due.<sup>5</sup> But to the one who does not work, but believes in Him who justifies the ungodly, his faith is credited as righteousness

### **Romans 5:1**

Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.

### **1 Corinthians 15:1-2**

<sup>1</sup>Now I make known to you, brethren, the gospel which I preached to you, which also you received, in which also you stand, <sup>2</sup>by which also you are saved, if you hold fast the word which I preached to you, unless you believed in vain.

### **Galatians 2:16**

<sup>16</sup>nevertheless knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the Law but through faith in Christ Jesus, even we have believed in Christ Jesus, so that we may be justified by faith in Christ and not by the works of the Law; since by the works of the Law no flesh will be justified.

***Soli deo Gloria: God alone gets all the glory for our salvation.***

### **Ephesians 1:6,12,14**

<sup>6</sup>to the praise of the glory of His grace, which He freely bestowed on us in the Beloved... <sup>12</sup>to the end that we who were the first to hope in Christ would be to the praise of His glory... <sup>14</sup>who is given as a pledge of our inheritance, with a view to the redemption of *God's own* possession, to the praise of His glory.

### **Ephesians 2:8-9**

<sup>8</sup>For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God; <sup>9</sup>not as a result of works, so that no one may boast.

### **Romans 11:36**

<sup>36</sup>For from Him and through Him and to Him are all things. To Him *be* the glory forever. Amen.

### **Romans 4:2-3**

<sup>2</sup>For if Abraham was justified by works, he has something to boast about, but not before God. <sup>3</sup>For what does the Scripture say? "ABRAHAM BELIEVED GOD, AND IT WAS CREDITED TO HIM AS RIGHTEOUSNESS."

### **Revelation 5:9-10,13**

<sup>9</sup>And they \*sang a new song, saying, "Worthy are You to take the book and to break its seals; for You were slain, and purchased for God with Your blood *men* from every tribe and tongue and people and nation. <sup>10</sup>"You have made them *to be* a kingdom and priests to our God; and they will reign upon the earth." <sup>13</sup>And every created thing which is in heaven and on the earth and under the earth and on the sea, and all things in them, I heard saying, "To Him who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb, *be* blessing and honor and glory and dominion forever and ever."

### **1 Corinthians 1:30-31**

<sup>30</sup>But by His doing you are in Christ Jesus, who became to us wisdom from God, and righteousness and sanctification, and redemption, <sup>31</sup>so that, just as it is written, "LET HIM WHO BOASTS, BOAST IN THE LORD."
