

Hey everyone, exciting news! This Sunday marks the start of a new worship series, "A Little More Like Jesus." It is inspired by the UMC Council of Bishops' fresh vision for our connectional church.

Think loving like Jesus - showing kindness to everyone, even when it's tough. It also means being compassionate and helping those in need, just as Jesus did. And importantly, it's about practicing humility and extending forgiveness to others. Our world needs us to be more like Jesus. One practical way to be more like Jesus is to serve in First St Charles ministries. Right now, we need volunteers to lead, teach, and shepherd our children and youth on Sunday mornings. Would you pray about saying yes to our Next Generation?

I'm really looking forward to exploring these themes together and discovering practical ways we can reflect Jesus' light in our community and beyond. It's going to be an inspiring month, and I hope you'll join us each week as we journey towards becoming a little more like Jesus. See you on Sunday!
